

Once upon a time in the land of the animals and birds, there was famine, and they were dying of hunger and starvation.




And so the tortoise said to the little bird prove it.

Instead they killed the bird and ate it.


When the tortoise came back from where he has gone, he sang for the bird to defecate food for him to eat, because he was hungry and tired, but he heard no voice
