I had to cuss my landlord out because he did not fix a damn thing. Enter- Daniel

This is my oldest son Daniel he is nine years old, but the he has ADHD. Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder.

Daniel: Mom. I do not know where to put all of my stuff at.

I want to play with my Xbox 360.

Jimmy: Mom. Can I please ride my bike? I am also hungry.

Henry: Moving is not fun mommy. Moving sucks.

Sally: I am Sally.

Geraldine: I am Geraldine

Georgia: And I am Georgia.

Geraldine: It was nice to meet you neighbors.

Sally: It was nice meeting you as well.

Have you thought about HACAP Hawkeye's Area Community Action Program to me homes on Highway 6 and Broadway St close to Broadway Neighborhood Center.

Georgia: It is next to the strip mall called Pepperwood Plaza.

Ruthie: Girl, please this is the projects.

Broadway St. is the projects too. Property Values in Southeast Side of Iowa City has went down in recent years.

Ramona: Mommy.

Geraldine: Yes Darling.

Ramona: Where is my Hello Kitty Scooter at? And where is my Hello Kitty pillow at?

pillow at.

Geraldine: Well, it is put up.

She tells Georgia and Molly that she applied for low income housing in cities in lowa.

Well, I tried applying for low income housing in Davenport, Waterloo, Muscatine, Cedar Rapids, Des Moines, and the only thing they have is this

piece of shit here on the Southeast Side of Iowa City. Enter-Max

Max: I would mess with no one in my hood by Broadway homes. It is near the lowa City Police Department inside Pepperwood Plaza where the fitness center used to be at.

Daniel: I want to be Herkey. Iowa Hawkeyes.

Geraldine: I came to Iowa from Chicago to get a better life. A better life from gangs, shootings, drug-dealing, prostitutes, bad ass kids, and all that other shit. But Chicago has the best food.

Daniel: Mom.

Geraldine: What is it son.

Daniel: Can we see our new bedroom?

Geraldine: I wonder if Mikos will buy me a business pass from lowa City or Coralville Transit?

Sally: You need to enroll your kids to Grantwood Elementary School. According to Daily Iowan and Iowa City Press Citizen Journalist Adam B. Sullivan, "Both Mark Twain and Grantwood Elementary School have a free lunch program."

Jimmy: I hate being poor. Is this better than Chicago?

I also do not want anyone to make fun of me.

The kids in lowa City will make fun of me for not having designer clothes. This is a college town called the university of lowa and Chicago transplants.

Geraldine: Son would you stay out of grown folks business?

Jimmy: But mom.

Geraldine: Go play.

I am pretty sure that your brothers and sisters would want to play with you.

Jimmy: Yes Ma'am.

Sally: Have you applied for food shelves and vouchers such as the crisis center?

Geraldine: I talked to Mr. Mikos Mitchell and Miss Heather Calrson about the boys and girls clothes at the Crowded Closet Thrift Store and the lowa City Crisis Center.

Mr. Mitchell and miss Carlson are willing to help us out in lowa City.

I am glad to move into Transitional Housing from the Domestic Violence Shelter.

Enter-Georgia

Georgia: I know what HACAP stands for. It stands for Hawkeye Area Community Action Program.

Jimmy: Mom. How did Auntie Georgia memorize that acronym?

I hear the doorbell ringing.

Geraldine: I'll get it. I bet it is the social workers for me and the kids.

Ruthie: I am glad that they are here.

Sally: Me too.

Enter-Mikos and Heather Carlson

Mikos: Hi.

I'm Mikos. I am a teaching assistant and a social worker from the University of lowa.

Heather Carlson: My name is Heather. I am a volunteer at Home Ties Day Care Center, and the Crisis Center.

Mikos: Sometimes, I go inside of the Shelter House on Southgate Ave.

Heather Carlson: I will be mostly inside of the Crisis Center distributing food, toiletries, and books.

Mikos: Would you help them out by filling out food, clothing, and utility vouchers for Geraldine's family and children. Normally I would have to go in front of the crisis center but, I could write you all a food, clothing, rent, utility book, and toiletry vouchers.

Heather Carlson: And, I have bus passes for everyone except for Henry and Ramona because they are under the age of 5.

Mikos: The lowa City bus passes are good for lowa City, Coralville, North Liberty, University Heights, and even the University of lowa campus. That would also include the Oakdale Campus.

Geraldine: Oh thank you very much Mr. Mitchell and Ms. Carlson. This is my roommate Georgia. We met when we were in the domestic violence shelter. We were also roommates when we lived there.

Georgia: Mikos and Heather, I am from West Des Moines Iowa but, I was in the domestic violence shelter in both Burlington and Waterloo, Iowa before I relocated to Iowa City.

Mikos: And you said that you is from the west side of Chicago? You lived in the North Lawndale neighborhood of K-Town and Garfield Park?

Heather Carlson: I am glad that I were able to help you out.

Mikos: The University of Iowa has recently built the urgent care clinic on Tenth Street and First Avenue in Coralville.

Heather Carlson: I could help get you and your children access to the free clinic on Towncrest and Muscatine Ave.

Jimmy: Is it on the east side of lowa City?

Daniel: Yes it is.

Mikos: it seems like Daniel has ADHD Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, bi-polar disorder, and OCD Obsessive Compulsive Disorder. And as for myself, I was diagnosed with Asperger's Syndrome which, is a mild form of Autism. According to the DSM Diagnostic Statistical Manual fifth edition, Asperger's Syndrome will no longer be in the DSM diagnosis. Instead, it will be called ASD Autistic Spectrum Disorder.

Geraldine: How did you overcome your Asperger's Syndrome?

Mikos: It is hard- well, I guess helping people especially children, older adults, and crisis intervention. Furthermore, I keep myself busy by contributing.

Heather Carlson: I am glad that you are able to help them out.

Mikos: You have to look at the positives of living in lowa. No more disconnect notices like in Chicago.

Geraldine: Thank you very much Mr. Mitchell and Ms. Carlson.

Act I, sc. ii.

Scene: Inside of Lakeside Apartments. Iowa City Iowa

July 12, 2011

Geraldine: Today is July 12, 2011. My name is Geraldine, and I am from Chicago, Illinois. I was born at Mount Sinai Hospital on July 16, 1989, on Chicago's Westside. I am stressed out because recently I was evicted from my old apartment because of the damn slum lords would not take my rent money; and Daniel, my son, wasvrecently expelled from an elementary school. He has attachment disorder and ADHD which is Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder. My next to my oldest son is 7 years old. His name is Jimmy. Although he is funny, he can be a little hyper active from over eating sweets and soda. Otherwise he is a bit chubby but a Chicago Cubs fan. He loves Pixar's Cars and Cars 2 movies. My youngest son, Henry is 5 years old. He is excited about kindergarten. But he wets the bed sometimes because he has night terrors and frequent nightmares. I want to call my 3 year old daughter, Ramona a princess. But in actuality, she is a spoiled brat. She hits all of her siblings and destroyed the room. Although my oldest child Daniel and my youngest child Ramona both are a pain in the neck, I love my children unconditionally. As far as for me, I used to weigh 250 pounds and I now weigh 110 pounds, yes I was a drug addict. I sold my Illinois link card which it is a food stamp time card for marijuana (weed)! crack/cocaine" heroin, and meth. I know that I am trying to be cleann I am also addicted to Red Bull energy drinks, Starbucks coffee, No Noz yellow caffeine pills, caffeine powder, and caffeine jels. I talked to Mr. Mikos Milan Mitchell and Heather Lynn Carlson from the University of Iowa urgent care, and the Iowa City crisis center. By the way, back in Chicago, I filed a restraining order against my ex boyfriend Joshua and soon to be ex husband William aka Billy. My soon to ex husband and my ex boyfriend physically, verbally, and financially abused me. He tried to sell food stamps for crack/cocaine and heroin and he tried to touch my three year old little girl Ramona. I told William if you ever think about touching or hurting my little girl, I will hurt you, you son of a bitch!!! And I will go to jail!!! Anyway, I can be a psycho bitch, and I am a bitch because my mother, biological father, and stepfather physically and verbally abused me as a child

and teenager. I used to get ass whoopins from them with the belt. My mother lives with my stepfather in the Chicago suburb called Summit/Argo, Illinois, where the projects once stood across the street from the Summit Villas. My stepfather is an drug addict and alcoholic. My biological dad, the asshole, lives in West Englewood on Chicago Southwest Side. I do not like Chicago nor the south suburbs. Too much violence, drugs, gangs, Latin Kings fucking with GDs (Gangster Disciples/Growth and Development), People messing with the police or more. I was ready to move to lowa to get away from crime drama and both the Cook County and Iowa City housing authority. I applied for several section 8 programs and low-income housing through Waterloo Housing Authority, Des Moines housing authority, Davenport housing authority, Cedar Rapids housing authority, Marshalltown housing authority and Clinton housing authority. I love lowa City so much but please say that please stay away from Broadway Street and Cross Park Avenue? The reason is because its like a mini Chicago. It has drugs, gangs, prostitution, fights, and afew shootings. I would not want my roommate nor my kids involved in that toxic shit!!! But at least out here, there are willing to help. Besdides, my three boys might be going to either Mark Twain or Grantwood Elementary School. Over 90% of the students are African American or receive free or reduced lunch program. Dr. Jefferson and Dr Dubuque is the lowa vocational rehabilitation counselors. It's also a great ideal for lowa City to open the Southeast Side Library so that Daniel and Jimmy could have access to a wifi and internet instead of me calling them bad ass kids!!! I love you lowa City. God, please help me find a job in lowa City and the University of Iowa? I will call Dr. Jefferson and Dr. Dubuque.

Scene Two Ends.

July 16, 2011

Scene: Downtown Iowa City. Inside of Iowa City Public Library in the Pedestrian Mall.

Iowa City Coralville North Liberty Book Festival.

Mikos speaks on the microphone

Mikos: Welcome to the 2011 lowa City/ Coralville/North Liberty/and University Heights Book Festival.

Heather Carlson: And Iowa City is the city of Literature.

This is why I love to live, work, study, and play in lowa City. I will be selling books as a sponsor to the University of Iowa, Uptown Bills Small Mall, Dance Marathon, Iowa City/Coralville Transit, HACAP *Hawkeye Area Community Action Program*, Hyvee, The Shelter House, and Mercy Hospital Iowa City.

Heather Carlson: I have been to lowa City Jazz Festival, Art Festival, and now, the Book Festival.

Enter Geraldine and Georgia

Geraldine: I am trying to raise money for the lowa City Book Festival, The Shelter House, and trying to fix bad neighborhoods of Chicago south and west sides in addition to, lowa City southeast side, Lakeside apartments aka the projects and Broadway Street Apartments/Townhomes aka the other lowa City projects.

Mikos: Ramona and Henry. What are you doing?

Geraldine: Uncle Mikos said do you want Ice Cream? Enter-Henry and Ramona

Henry: Mommy.

Henry and Ramona: Mommy, We want ice cream!

Heather Carlson: Miss Geraldine. Hayley from Bratayley is going through terrible twos. Just like Ramona. I think she meant to say that her brother Henry makes her mad.

Ramona: Mommy. I got to go pee pee.

Geraldine: You have to potty?

Ramona: Yes ma. ma. Georgia takes Ramona potty. Exit-Ramona and Georgia.

Geraldine: Well, maybe them bad ass Lil lids needs to stop watching Bratayley on You Tube and Annie from Acroanna. We are here to sell books, and have fun in lowa City. Reenter-Tyler Perry

Tyler Perry: I will give you \$500 to help you guys out in addition to give out a free book that I have wrote.

Geraldine and Georgia: May we have your autograph?

Geraldine: my oldest son has ADHD in addition to having nose bleeds. Boys, would you stop that shit please? I'm trying to raise money to help fix the southeast side for urban renewal.

Geraldine: We raised about \$1,400. The should be enough to pay rent, buy groceries, and clothing. Personally, I wouldn't buy clothing from the Salvation
