

### AR15 Presents Wretch 32, Devlin, Rebecca Garton & Swiss - Helpless (Produced by S.O.S)

A compelling contrast between the urban vocals against the beautiful notes and sweeter vocals.

#AR15 #ConcreteJungle is being kept under close guard and apart from two tracks, 'Trapping Aint Dead' and 'Out In The Jungle', that have made it to the internet, the project remains largely under wraps but amid the intrigue and suspense, from the teasers that have dropped so far and the feature list of over 50 acts that are involved, it is already high in the stakes of being the biggest release in UK Rap this year.

'Helpless' is the third track to be heard from the 16 track mix-tape and features an impressive, all-star cast with Devlin, Wretch 32 and So Solid Crew veteran Swiss all getting deep with their lyrics, as they describe their tough road to success. The sweet sound of Rebecca Garton on the hook and S.O.S on production makes 'Helpless' one of the many gems on the impressive tracklist and undoubtedly will become a firm favorite to many.

'Helpless' is a solid follow up to 'Trapping Aint Dead' and 'Out in the Jungle'. Featuring the Section Boyz, 'Trapping Aint Dead' hit the 1Xtra playlist, MTV playlist, picked up support across the United States and Europe and has received nearly a million hits online within it's first two months of release, which is a respectable achievement for any introductory single.

As one of the first successful independent record labels within the UK urban music scene, Alwayz Recordings has built a legacy which has helped to oversee the rise to fame for Chip, Wretch 32 andPaigey Cakey along with numerous other acts. In collaboration with GB Records, the two labels have joined together to create a mix-tape built on a foundation that understands the roots and reality of many emcees, commanding a respect that has enabled its founders to place unexpected emcees together to create a project of exciting, interesting and huge proportions.

### 1. Tell us a bit about yourself and how you got into music.

I'm 27 and a model/dj from London town... I've been into music from a very young age — always singing around the house and forcing my mum to listen to my put-on concerts in the front room!! Hip Hop and RnB has always been my thing... But I appreciate music from all genres, and at the moment for me it's all about supporting the UK music movement (Grime and Trap). It's our time in my opinion.

#### 2. You've just started your very first radio shows on Southstar Radio, how do you find this compares to playing at events?

My family at Southstar Radio have shown me nothing but love, especially my boy Captain Rosko. It's a fantastic opportunity that I'm grabbing with both hands!! I've always wanted to be on radio, so for me it's a dream come true: Its very different from events and parties I've done in the past, I

It sounds cheesy and plenty have said it before me but music is my life. Its got me through good and bad times and the first thing I do when I wake up, even before I put the kettle on for that all important first coffee of the day, is crank up the tunes!!

#### 6. What are your aspirations for the future?


The future is an open book, I'm a big believer in 'life is what you make it' ... I intend to pursue my music and

This release comes at you with a feisty attitude and dark edgy basslines.


