

India is a country where diverse cultures flourish. Here wedding attires depend on the religion and the region

Hindus

Dresses for Hindu wedding greatly depend on the region or state. South Indian men wear traditional White Dhotis and some people wear Pancha which is Dhoti tied in a different style. It is often paired with White Shirt and colorful Turban. North Indian grooms wear colorful heavily embroidered Sherwanis with matching Turbans.

Women in India are generally noted for colorful Saris. South Indian Bride is generally made up with Saris made of traditional Kanjeevaram silk. Kerala women wear cream colored Saris with colorful Blouse. The jewels they wear makes up for the dull color of saris. Brides in North India are characterized by heavily worked Lehangas in colors like red or gold.



Christians

Christianity is a world religion. In India Christian women wear white Prom Dress or Gown with a Veil and a Bouquet. In some South Indian Christian weddings bride wears Sari. Bride Groom wears White Shirt, Black Suit and Tie with black pants.



Muslims

Wedding of Muslims are much more colorful. The bride's dress is called Gharara Sharara which is similar to wedding gowns except for they are fully covered and has long sleeves. It is paired with a matching Veil or Hijab.

Groom dresses according to their culture, normally sherwani or Suit and Tie.

Punjabi weddings are celebrated with great joy. Bride wears bright Salwar Kameez or Lehangas. Groom wears sherwani with colored Turbans.


