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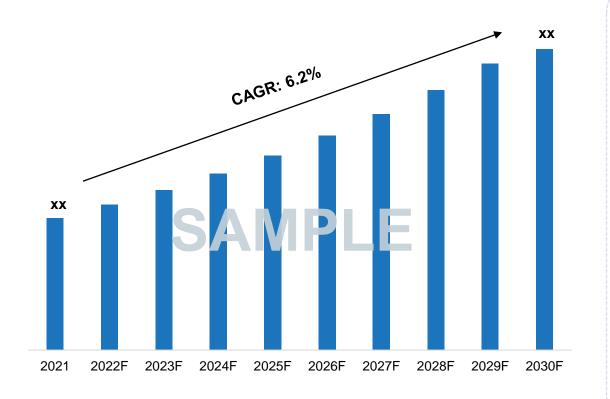

1.1 Introduction

- Home care also referred to as domiciliary care, social care, or in-home care, is medical treatment provided at home by the licensed healthcare provider
- There is increased awareness amongst patients and their families, and initiatives by public and private sectors developed over a short time have contributed to the growth of home healthcare
- It is expected that the dependence on home care through both public and private sectors will increase in UAE. This will further be aided by the current technological advances, such as 5G, ERP systems, unified medical records, and digital platforms, promoting an enhanced environment for home care delivery
- It is expected to see a gradual transfer of patients from a hospital setup to home care to ensure effective delivery of care to citizens in the UAE

2.1.1 Launch of home care services by various hospital

- The initiatives taken by hospitals are expected to boost the growth of the market
- Zulekha hospital introduced Zulekha Home Care to ensure access to high-quality healthcare from the comfort of one's home. The home care services cover visits by doctors and nurses, physiotherapy, investigations, medication management, and medical equipment rentals
- Pyramid Health Services, part of Hayat Health entered the Dubai market that offers experienced medical care to pediatric, geriatric, and adult patients at home across a wide spectrum

2.1.2 Favorable government support programs

- Market growth is expected to be boosted by favorable regional government backing
- For example, the Department of Health Abu Dhabi launched an updated model for home care services as part
 of the department's efforts to assure qualified patients' access to high-quality home care services
- The Department of Health certified 77 home care service providers who would serve approximately 4,000 patients and is dedicated to updating and adopting advanced care models that improve the sector's efficiency and contribute to the provision of healthcare services that meet the highest international standards

2.1.3 Introduction of technologically improved products

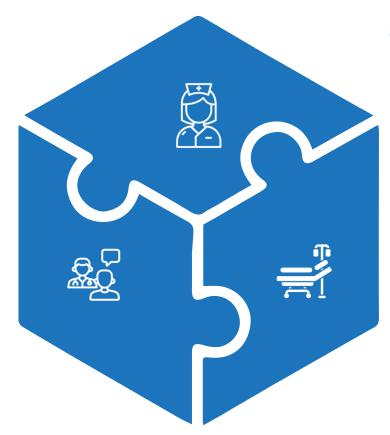
- Introducing technologically improved products is expected to accelerate market expansion
- SUR Universal of Ramat Gan, Israel, teamed with the Hamad Bin Khalifa (HBK) Department of Projects of the UAE to develop HBKiCare, a white-label smart IoT healthcare solution for the UAE and the Middle Eastern markets
- Introduction of HBKiCare, an IoT platform and home care kit that allows for continuous ECG, temperature, pulse, blood oxygen, and blood pressure monitoring
- With AI-based insights and voice-activated interaction via Google Home, Amazon Alexa, or Baidu, the product can also detect falls and monitor Activities of Daily Living (ADLs) and personal whereabouts

 Physician engagement is a longrunning issue in home health, as a lack of timely signatures and thorough understanding of the home health benefit creates bottlenecks in care

2.2.1 Retaining qualified licensed nurses

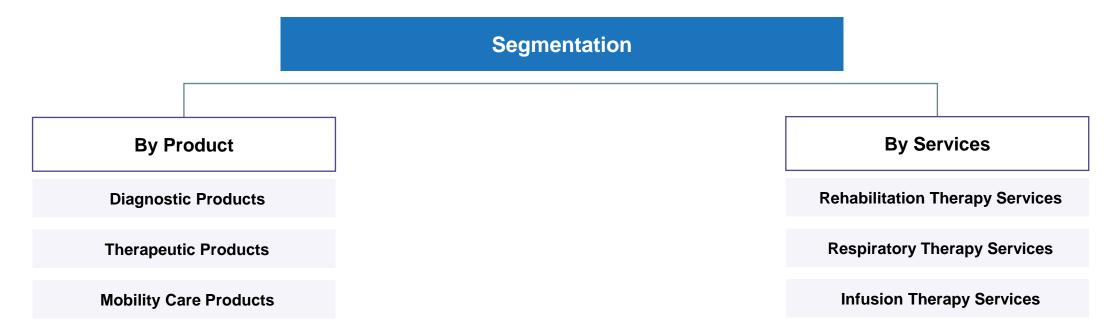
- Attracting and retaining talented nursing staff has been ranked as the top challenge by Home Health agencies
