'The Uncommercial Traveller' was published in a volume in 1861, and contained seventeen papers. In 1865 a new edition, dated 1866, was issued with eleven more papers added, and in 1875 the volume appeared in the 'Illustrated Library Edition' with a further addition of eight papers. The last paper to be included in the volume was 'A Fly Leaf in a Life,' which appeared in the 'Gadshill' Edition in 1890. All these papers were originally contributed to 'All the Year Round' between 1860 and 1869, and are included in this volume in chronological order. This Edition contains all the copyright emendations made in the text as revised by the Author in 1867 and 1868.
