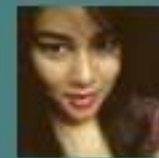

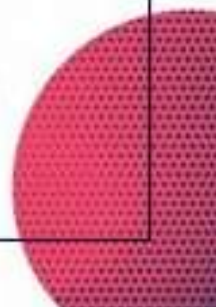

Bruno Mars

Peter Gene Hernandez, professionally known as Bruno Mars was born on October 8, 1985 in Honolulu, Hawaii. 'Bruno' came from a childhood nickname when his dad thought his son resembled professional wrestler Bruno Sammartino. 'Mars' from his quote "...a lot of girls say I'm out of this world, so I was like I guess I'm from Mars,"

Growing up in a musical family, he was introduced to many genres at a young age. He was known around his island as the four-year-old Elvis Presley impersonator. He moved to Los Angeles post-high school in hopes to launch a music career. In 2009, he was signed by Atlantic records. Here, he co-founded the production team The Smeezingtons which is responsible for singles "Nothing on You" by B.o.B. and "Billionaire" by Travie McCoy. Following those was his debut album *Doo-Wops & Hooligans* in 2010. 2012 brought his second studio album called *Unorthodox Jukebox*.

To date, he has sold over 100 million singles and albums worldwide, making him one of the best-selling artists of all time. He has won four Grammys. He has landed six number-one singles on the Billboard Hot 100, attaining his first five faster than any male artist since, coincidentally, Elvis Presley. Makes sense why people describe him as out of this world.

The album title says it all. Sinbioz (symbiosis) the state where foreign bodies are able to live a close relationship. Flashback is a typical representation of the Mauritian society; its diversity and blend.

I recently discovered their album and what strikes most is the sound and rhythm of the first piece giving a very good feel, which is reproduced on all tracks. What are experienced: a joy and a will to communicate their musical style and their creations.

Even if the album is very groovy, the content is deep. The subjects are exposed in a subtle way but bring us to give another thought of prostitution, the next generation future, gender relationship, but most of all an ode to music.

One track which caught me is Resers Lidantite (Search for Identity). A strong message from Flashback that makes us think about our cultural blend and how we need to fight to get our culture exposed, not as different entities of the Mauritian society but as Mauritians in a holistic approach.

Flashback is having a powerful punch. A message sent to the new generation which is full of hope and that there is no barrier to success. We must not remain in conformed state of mind. They are proving that we must not hesitate to take the next step to make our dreams come true.
