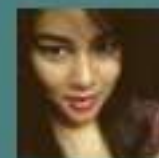

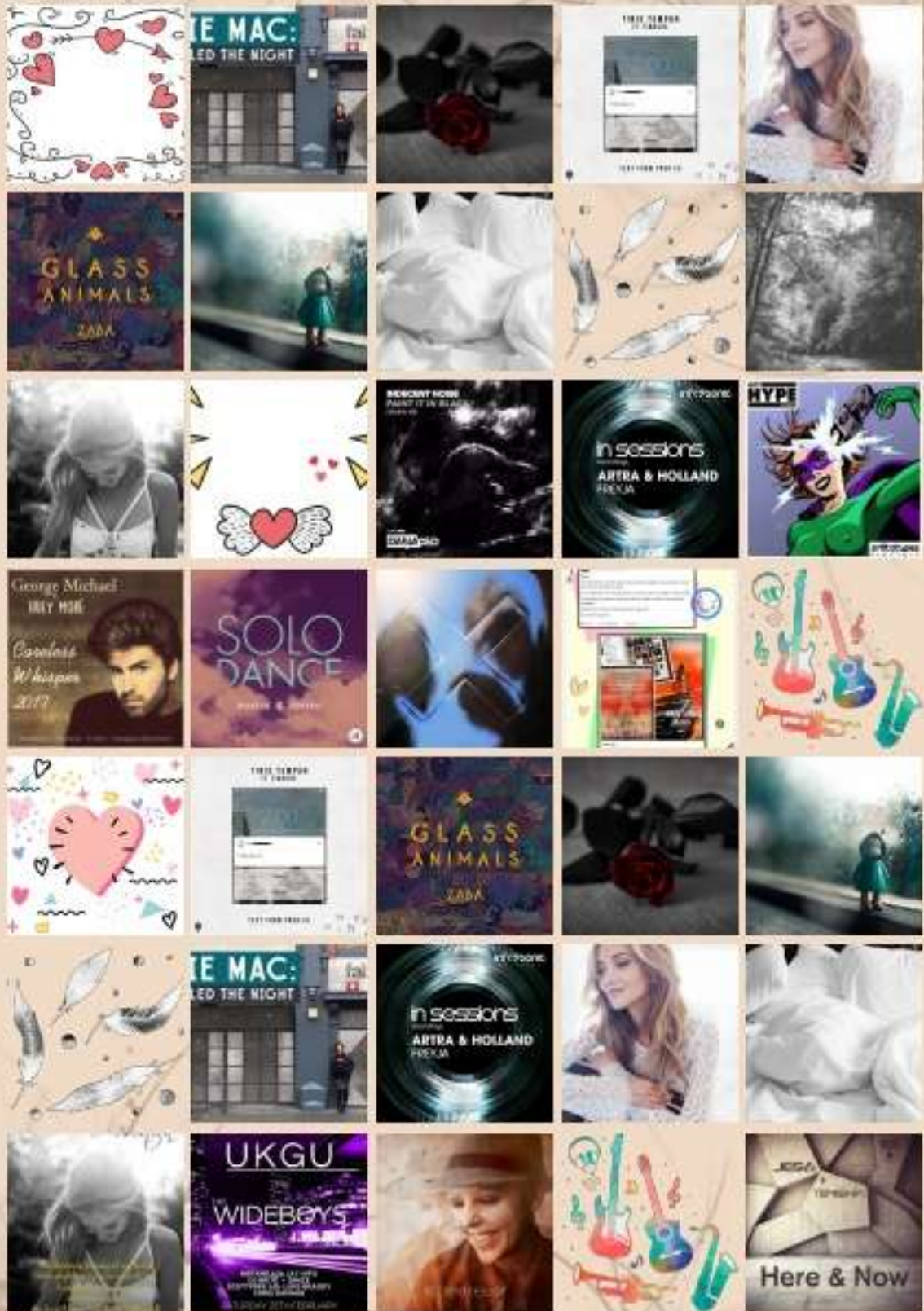

but I know that were strong enough to mend.

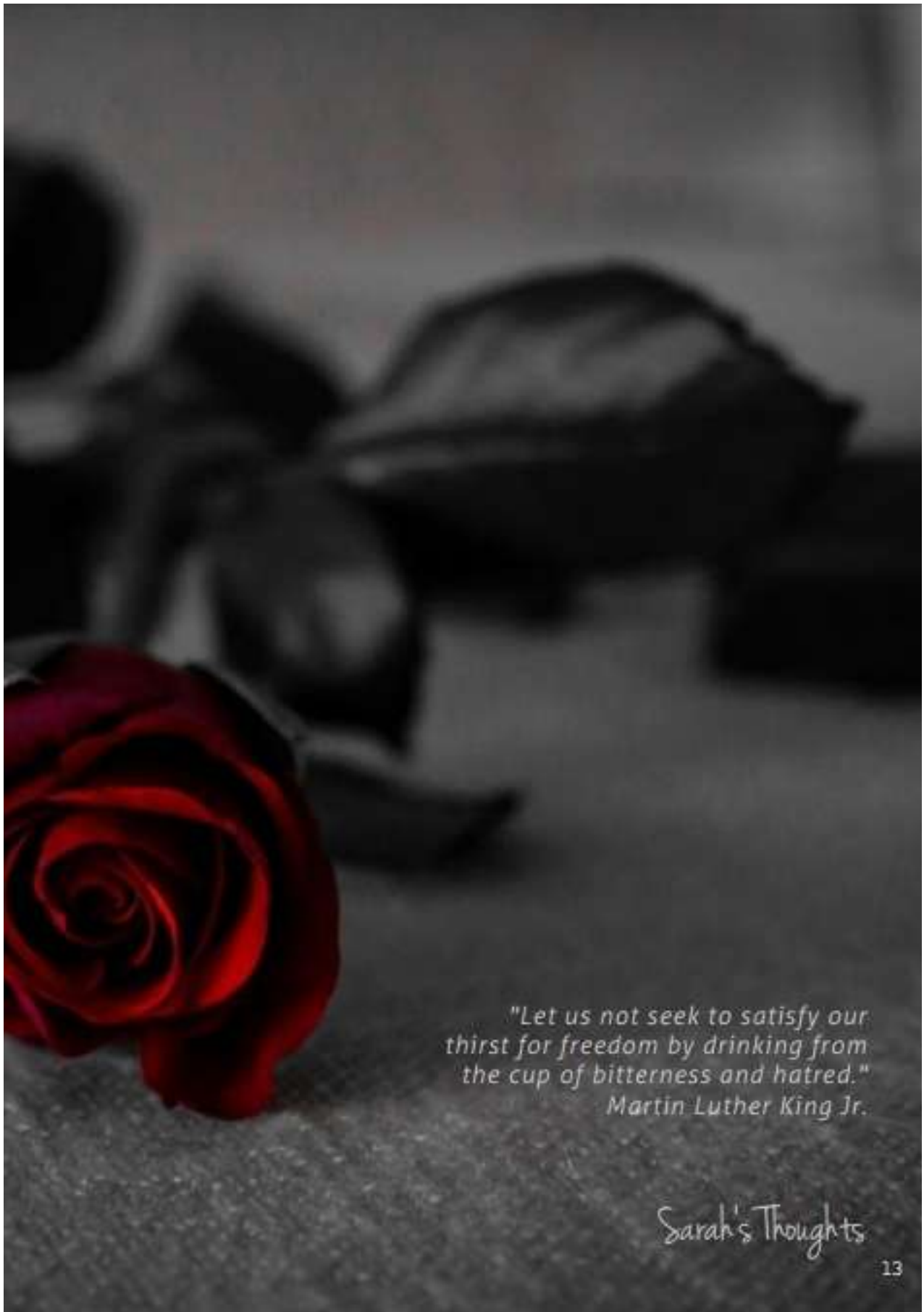
And so I'll fight and defend, my love'
