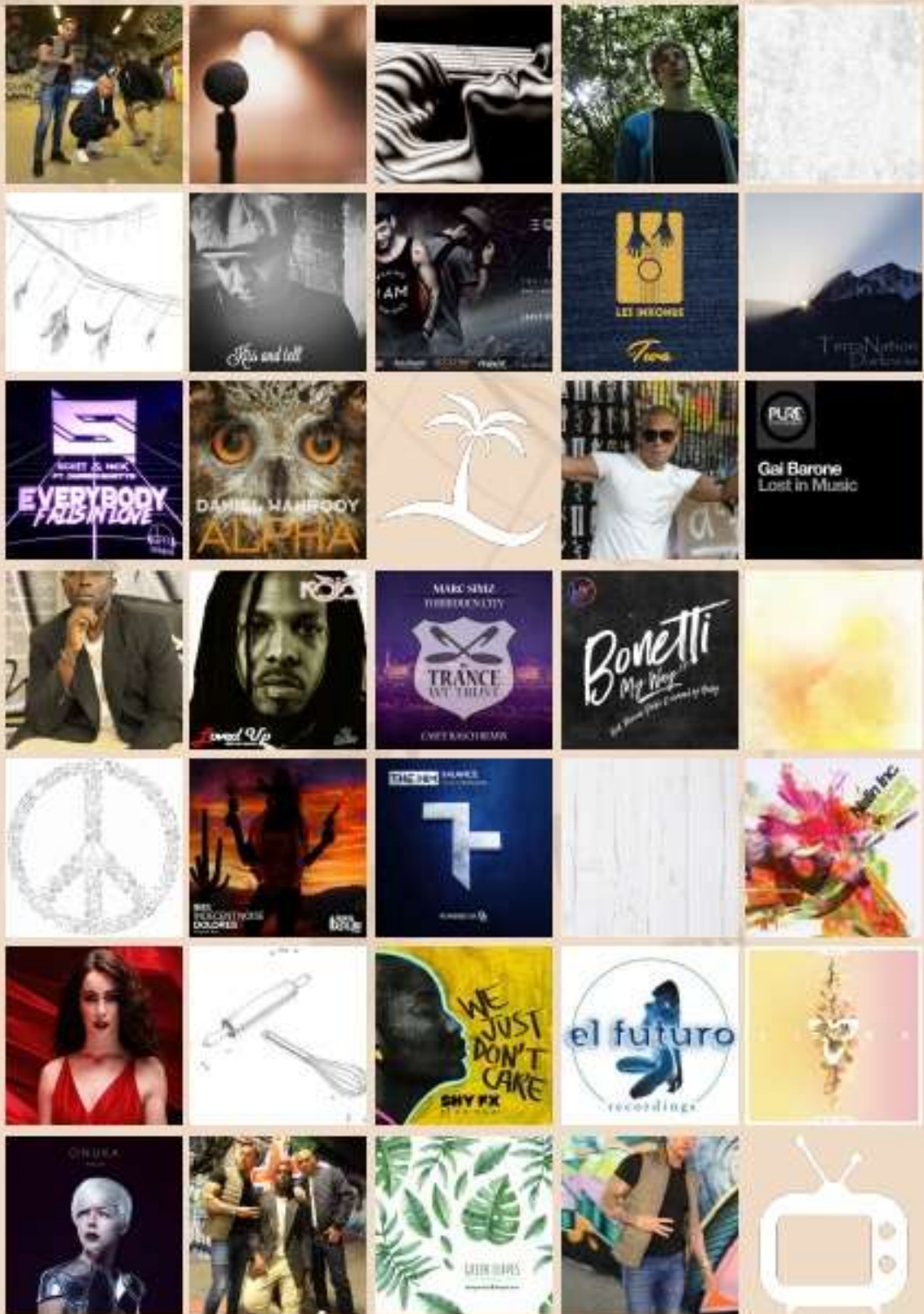

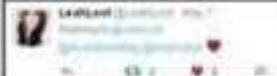

UK3'S THINGS THAT MAKE ME

VAN ELST

Frank van der Ploeg, otherwise known as VAN ELST is a Dutch musician with big projects coming out this month. His debut single, 'Gold Waves' was released on May 16, which is the first single off his upcoming EP. I was able to interview him about his passion for music, incorporating his culture in his music and what he hopes for in his career.

How would you describe yourself as an artist, and where do you see your career going as a musician?

As an artist I would say I'm often lost in time; a sensitive dreamy soul who expresses and channels his deepest emotions, memories and experiences through gloomy melancholic electronic music. When creating music, I strive for the ideal mix of organic with the more abstract modern world.

Where my musical career is going? In these uncertain times it's hard to say but I hope to find myself being successful in a sense that I can release more music, bring the project alive by gigging in vibes venues and build a following wherever possible. It would be satisfying to witness people finding a musical home in my

creations to consolidate their hearts and fulfill their unknown desires.

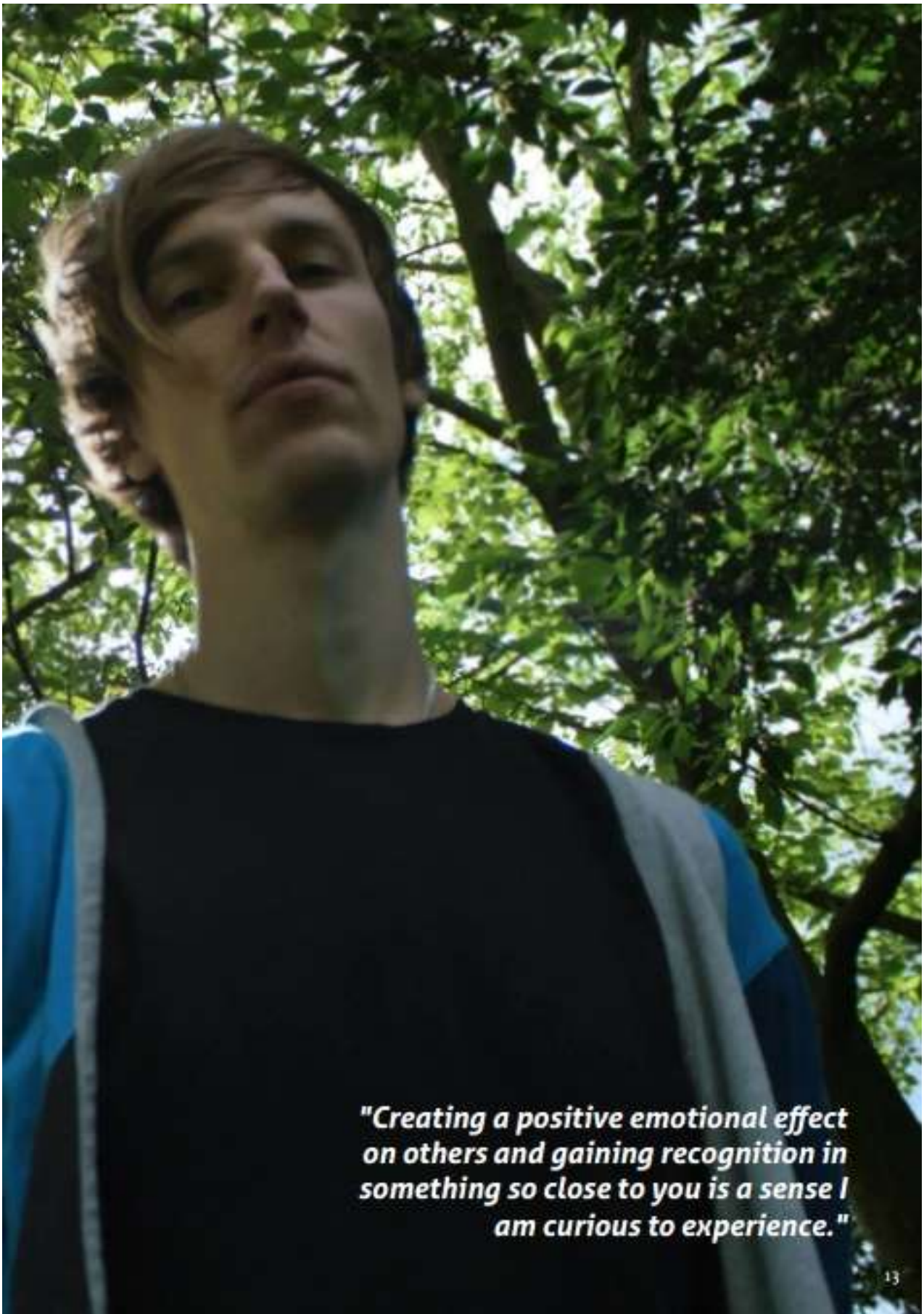
How did you come up with your stage name?

My stage name came to me rather than me coming up with the name. It is something I have carried with me all my life but only appeared in my mind after a series of events. People close to me will know where it exactly came from. It is definitely made out of many important life factors such as love, passion and experiencing getting lost in mystical forests combined with a drift across dark gritty urban landscapes. As far as I know the meaning of the name is continuing to shape itself. Until when? I don't know.

Talk about how you incorporate your Dutch roots with living in London musically.

I'd like to think my Dutch roots made me absorb things in life with an open mind. Having travelled and lived in several places, including China, shaped me as a person as well as an artist. From every single one of these places I have taken a piece of experience and its culture with which I then constructed my own perception of

home. This search and construction reflects back onto my music.

When I first moved to London to pursue music I felt slightly alienated and overwhelmed by its size and huge drain like appearance on grey rainy days. These circumstances gave me a great deal of nostalgic emotions as I tried to ground myself. Over the years I have started to feel more accustomed to the city and managed to channel these complex comparative emotions into creating music. With my music I try create; a sense of reminiscence to my scattered roots of comfort, a place I feel very passionate about, that travels with me wherever I go, a space I call a nostalgic wanderlust home.

Who are your biggest inspirations?

First of all I would say family. Besides that, people who broke my heart play a role in both positive and negative ways as a break up can leave a bitter sweet taste and are a great source of creativity. I also love going out to a random venue in London and checking out bands. The passion of these underground musicians and their music often inspires me and wants me to push my own boundaries.

Besides people, I also get inspiration out of the contrast between nature and city. I love getting drowned in the serenity of an open field after leaving a buzzing busy city. I recently was fortunate to camp out in the middle of an African savannah and the huge contrast between its darkness at night and the never ending London city lights I usually experience inspired me a lot.

Do you have any upcoming shows/releases?

Last week I released my first music video 'Gold waves'. The next step is to get a few songs to be mixed and mastered for an EP which should be out sometime around June. A live show is still in the making and I am hoping to do it after the EP is out.

What is the single most important thing you want your fans to experience through your music?

Emotion. Often people think black and white as in happy and sad. I'd like to think that my music can bring both elements together.

By writing songs, I can often find a reason to why I think or feel a certain way. Especially in this day

of age where negative news feeds and social media rule our minds. Trying to search for meaning in my work gives me comfort and a better understanding of myself and my surroundings. I hope the listeners will be able to find their own answers to their emotions while listening to VAN ELST. During their search for explanation, I imagine people dancing to their own downheartedness, darkest dreams and desires with my music as a soundtrack to their physical motions bringing them to higher spirits.

Creating a positive emotional effect on others and gaining recognition in something so close to you is a sense I am curious to experience.

If you don't feel like going to a crowded gig, I recommend listening to the music with a headphone splitter as I believe sharing music in this intimate way can bring us closer in interesting ways.

VAN ELST's debut video was released on May 16 and will be followed by a 3 track EP due to come out in June. Currently VAN ELST is working on a live set and plans to perform in and around London. Upcoming shows will be

announced on his website in the coming month.

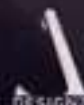
