- 1. A heavenly inheritance, incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fades not away, reserved in heaven for me' no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ' Galatians 4:7 1st Peter 1:4
- 2. A blessed home; my home is blessed for God 'blesses the home of the just' Proverbs 3:33
- 3. A child of God; 'I am a child of God by faith in Christ Jesus' 'I am being changed from glory to glory ... by the Spirit of the Lord' Galatians 3:26, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 3:18
- 4. A glorified body; 'I look for my Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: who shall change my vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able to subdue all things unto himself' Philippians 3:20-21
- 5. A God planned life; 'my steps are ordered by the Lord: and I delight in his way' 'In all my ways I acknowledge him, and he directs my paths' Psalm 87:23; Proverbs 3:6.
- 6. Access to God; 'through Christ I have access by one Spirit unto my heavenly Father' Ephesians 2:18

- 7. **An heir of God;** 'I am no more a servant, but a son, an heir of God through Christ' Galatians 4:7
- 8. Adoption; for he has given me 'the Spirit of adoption and now I can call my God, my Abba, my Father, my Daddy' Galatians 4:6
- 9. All things pertaining to life and godliness; are mine through the knowledge of him who has called me to glory and virtue' 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 1:3
- 10. Anointing; that destroys the yoke' Isaiah 10:27
- 11. An incorruptible and undefiled inheritance; one 'that fades not away, reserved in heaven for me. I am kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time' 1st Peter 1:4-5
- 12. Answers to my prayers; whatsoever I ask believing my heavenly Father in Jesus name he will give it to me' before I call, and while I am yet speaking, God will hear' Matthew 21:22, Isaiah 65:24

- 13. **Born Again;** I am born again unto a living hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. To an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that fades not away, reserved in heaven for me; 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 1:3-4
- 14. Children; 'God makes the barren woman to keep house and to be the joy mother of children' 'none shall miscarry' For children are a heritage from the Lord, and the fruit of the womb is his reward' Exodus 23:26, Psalm 113:9, Psalm 127:3
- 15. Chosen by God; 'I am chosen in him before the foundation of the world' and 'I am accepted in the beloved' Ephesians 1:4, Ephesians 1:6
- 16. **Comfort;** in my sorrow for 'he will not leave me comfortless' he has sent me 'another comforter the Holy Ghost who will abide with me forever' John 14:16-18
- 17. **Contentment:** 'I am content in whatsoever state I am in' Philippians 4:11
- 18. Cleansing; His blood cleanses me from all sin past present and future as I walk in the light and fellowship with him' 1<sup>st</sup>John 1:7

- 19. A crown of victory; 'Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing' 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 4:8
- 20. **Daily bread;** Gods word filled with all the promises of God which are in Christ Yes and amen; John 6:36, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1:20
- 21. **Deliverance;** from all 'my troubles and all my fears' deliverance to all in captivity' Psalm 34:4-6, Luke 4:18
- 22. **Deliverance from afflictions**; for though 'many are the afflictions of the righteous the Lord delivers us out of them all' Psalm 34:19
- 23. **Deliverance from despair and depression;** for 'the Lord is the glory and the lifter of my head' Psalm 3:3
- 24. **Deliverance from fear;** for 'God has not given me a spirit of fear but of love and of power and of a sound mind'  $2^{nd}$  Timothy 1:7

- 25. **Deliverance from the wicked;** 'he shall deliver me from the wicked' Psalm 37:40
- 26. A divine nature; 'I am a partaker of his divine nature by the exceeding great and precious promises which were given to me' 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 1:4
- 27. **Elected by God**; 'I am the elect of God, holy and beloved' Colossians 3:12
- 28. **Eternal salvation**; for 'no one can pluck me out of his hand' ('salvation' rescue or safety physically or morally, deliver, health) Hebrews 5:9
- 29. Everlasting life; because 'I believe in Christ I shall not perish, but have everlasting life for he that believes on the Son has everlasting life' John 3:15-16
- 30. Faith; For God gave me 'faith to believe in the grace that saved me' 'faith that moves mountains' for the life I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me' Ephesians 2:8, Mark 11:23, Galatians 2:20

- 31. **Favour:** I am surrounded with favour as a shield; Psalm 5:12
- 32. **Forgiveness**; for 'Christ came into the world to save sinners' and 'If I forgive those who sin against me he will forgive me' 'when I confess my sin he is faithful and just to forgive me and to cleanse me from all unrighteousness' 1<sup>st</sup> John 1:9,1<sup>st</sup> Timothy 1:15, Matthew 6:14
- 33. **Freedom;**Isaiah 53:8, for who the Son makes free is free indeed' John 8:36
- 34. Freedom from oppression; for he will 'break the oppressor in pieces' Psalm 72:4
- 35. Freedom from evil; for no evil will befall me' Psalm 91:10
- 36. **Freedom from the fear of death;** for 'my saviour Jesus Christ is the resurrection and the life' 1<sup>st</sup>John 4:18
- 37. Freedom from sin; For 'sin has no dominion over me' Romans 8:1-4

- 38. **Friendship**; for he is a friend that sticks closer than a brother' one who promises never to leave me or forsake me' Proverbs 18:24, Hebrews 13:5
- 39. **Fellowship with Christ;** 'I walk in the light as he is in the light and we have fellowship one with another' 1<sup>st</sup> John 1:7
- 40. **Grace**; by which I am saved' justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus' 'amazing grace that is sufficient' Ephesians 2:8, Romans 3:24, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 12:9
- 41. Good things; My God satisfies my mouth with good things so that my youth is renewed like the eagles' 'No good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly'; 'because I seek the Lord I shall not want any good thing' Psalm 103:5, Psalm 84:11, Psalm 34:10
- 42. **Happiness**; for happy is the man whose God is the Lord' Psalm 144:15

- 43. **Health**; purchased in full because Jesus himself took my infirmities and carried my sicknesses and by his stripes I am already healed' according to 'his highest wish that I be in **health**' (perfect soundness of health, mind, soul and body) Matthew 8:17, 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 2:24, 3<sup>rd</sup> John 2
- 44. **Help;** at his throne of grace I obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need' Hebrews 4:14-16
- 45. **Help to the poor;** 'God has promised to deliver the needy when he cries, the poor also, and him that has no helper' 'he shall spare the poor and the needy and shall save the souls of the needy' Psalm 72:12-13.
- 46. Help for the depressed; 'If my soul should melt for heaviness; (depression, grief and sorrow) the Lord will strengthen me according to his word' 'The Lord upholds all that fall, and raises up all those that are bowed down, (depressed) Psalm 119:28, Psalm 145:14
- 47. **His presence;** in which is 'fullness of joy and at his right hand there are pleasures for evermore' Psalm 16:11

- 48. **Hope;** that is 'sure and steadfast, an anchor for my soul''I look for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and my Saviour Jesus Christ and so shall I ever be with the Lord' Titus 2:13, Hebrews 6:19
- 49. Immunity from plagues; 'no evil shall befall me and no plague shall come near my dwelling place for the Lord will preserve me from all evil' Psalm 91:10, Psalm 121:7
- 50. **Joy;** unspeakable and full of glory' and a merry heart that does good like a medicine'I am assured that 'while weeping may last for a night joy comes in the morning, 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 1:8, Proverbs 17:22, Psalm 30:5
- 51. Justice; I serve the 'God of justice' Isaiah 30:18
- 52. **Justification**; 'I am Justified by his grace, made an heir according to the hope of eternal life' Titus 3:7
- 53. **Kept by Gods power;** 'I am kept by the power of God through faith ready to be revealed in the last time; 1<sup>st</sup>Peter 1:5

- 54. **Kept from falling;** 'I am kept from falling and Christ will present me faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy' Jude 1:24
- 55. **Liberty**; for Christ has brought liberty to all who are bruised and downtrodden' (pardon, deliverance, forgiveness) Luke 4:18
- 56. **Life;** 'the life I now live and I live by the faith of the Son of God who loved me and gave his life for me' 'life more abundantly' Galatians 2:20, John 10:10
- 57. Living water' and I will never thirst again for Christ has given me a well of water springing up into everlasting life' John 4:10
- 58. Long Life; the Lord has promised to 'satisfy me with long life and to show me his salvation' 'I will keep his commandments, for length of days, and long life, and peace, will they add to me' Psalm 91:16; Proverbs 3:1-2
- 59. Love; for God so loved me that he gave his only begotten Son, that by believing in him I should not perish, but have everlasting life' John 3:16

- 60. Loving kindness and tender mercies; Psalm 103:
- 61. Mercy; that is 'new every morning' 'from everlasting to everlasting unto me' for my 'God is the Father of mercies' indeedhis 'abundant mercy has birthed me again unto a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead' 1st Peter 1:3, Lamentations 3:23 Psalm 103:17, 2nd Corinthians 1:3
- 62. No condemnation; 'Christ did not come into the world to condemn me; he 'came into the world so that I could be saved, (delivered, protected, preserved, healed and made whole) through him' John 3:17
- 63. No Separation; 'I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other creature shall be able to separate me from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus my Lord' Romans 8:38-39
- 64. Overcoming Faith: I have 'overcome the devil by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of my testimony' Revelation 12:11

- 65. **Peace;I** have peace that passes all understanding' not as the world gives but as Christ gave me' (peace, prosperity, quietness, rest) 'When I lie down, I shall not be afraid' 'I shall not be afraid for the terror by night, the arrow by day or pestilence in darkness; or for the destruction that waste at noonday' Psalm 91:5-8. Philippians 4:7, John 14:27, Proverbs 3:24
- 66. **Power;** the Holy Ghost is come upon me and I am a witness unto Christ Acts 1:8. for 'he has given me power to tread upon serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt me' Acts 1:8, Luke 10:19
- 67. **Power over temptation;** 'There has no temptation taken me but such as is common to man: But God is faithful, who will not suffer me to be tempted above that I am able; but will with every temptation will also make a way of escape that I may be able to bear it'1st Corinthians 10:13.
- 68. **Power over Satan;** 'I will resist the devil, and he will flee from me' 'Christ has given me power over all the power of the enemy and nothing shall by any means hurt me' James 4:7,Luke 10:19

- 69. **Praise;** 'praise puts pain and suffering in perspective, it sees Calvary's lamb, Christ enthroned not crucified, risen not dead, and victorious not defeated, it sees that because he lives we shall live also, it rejoices in our secure future and not the distant and ever receding past'
- 70. **Promises**; exceeding great and precious promises have made me a partaker of the divine nature of God' 'Promises that are Yes in Christ and in him amen' 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 1:4, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1:20
- 71. **Prosperity;** for 'he was made poor that through his poverty I might be rich' (wealthy)and his 'highest wish above all is that I may prosper' 'Wealth and riches dwell in my house for I fear the Lord and delight in his commandments' Psalm 112:1-3,2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 8:9,3<sup>rd</sup> John 2, Psalm 112:1-3
- 72. **Protection;** for my 'God is an enemy to my enemies and an adversary to my adversaries' 'my strong tower and my refuge' 'he shall rebuke the devourer for my sake' Exodus 23:22, Psalm 61:3, 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 22:3 Malachi 3:11

- 73. **Provision;** for 'the Lord is my shepherd I shall not want' 'he supplies all my need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus' Psalm 23:1, Philippians 4:19
- 74. Raised up; 'I am quickened together with Christ, even when I was dead in sins;' and I am raised up and have been made to sit in heavenly places in Christ Jesus' Ephesians 2:5, Ephesians 2:6
- 75. **Reconciliation;** 'to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, I shall be saved by his life' Romans 5:10
- 76. **Redemption;** 'through his blood, I have redemption, the forgiveness of my sins according to his riches of his grace' 'Christ hath redeemed me from the curse of the law, being made a curse for me' Ephesians 1:7, Galatians 3:13
- 77. **Refuge;** the Lord is a refuge when I am oppressed a refuge in times of trouble' Psalm 9:9

- 78. **Repentance;** 'The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering toward me, not willing that I should perish, but that I should come to repentance' 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 3:9
- 79. **Resurrection;** for 'Christ is the resurrection and the life' 'the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in me, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken my mortal body by his Spirit that dwells in me' Romans 8:11, John 11:25
- 80. **Renewed strength;** 'as I wait upon the Lord he renews my strength' Isaiah 40:29-31
- 81. **Renewed youth;** 'he satisfies my mouth with good things; so that my youth is renewed like the eagle's' Psalm 103:5
- 82. **Rest;** for the 'Lord is my shepherd he makes me to lie down in green pastures: he leads me beside the still waters' Psalm 23:2
- 83. **Riches wealth and honour;** yet another 'Yes and Amen promise of God in Christ' 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 1:12, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1:20
