








About This Book

The name of God is Yahweh.




Do you know who kept the very first Sabbath? Yahweh our God did.



For in six days Yahweh made the heavens, the earth, the sea, and everything in them; but on the seventh day he rested. That is why Yahweh blessed the Sabbath day and set it apart as holy. Exodus 20:11

When is the day of worship?



Sabbath-Saturday:

"You have six days each week for your ordinary work but the seventh day is a Sabbath day of complete rest, an official day for holy assembly. It is Yahweh's Sabbath day, and it must be observed wherever you live." Lev. 23:3 NLT

The Official Day For Holy Assembly

How do we keep the Sabbath holy? By learning and obeying the laws of the Sabbath.

Things we don't do on the Sabbath:

1. We don't work

"Be careful to keep my Sabbath day, for the Sabbath is a sign of the covenant between me and you from generation to generation. It is given so you may know that I am Yahweh, who makes you holy." Exodus 31:13

2. We don't tell others to work for us

"On that day no one in your household may do any work. This includes you, your sons and daughters, your male and female servants, your oxen and donkeys and other livestock, and any foreigners living among you. All your male and female servants must rest as you do." Deut. 5:14 NLT

3. We don't cook

"Tomorrow will be a day of complete rest, a holy Sabbath day set apart for Yahweh's. So bake or boil as much as you want today, and set aside what is left for tomorrow." Exo. 16:23

4. We don't buy, sell or trade

Then I commanded that the gates of Jerusalem should be shut as darkness fell every Friday evening, not to be opened until the Sabbath ended. I sent some of my own servants to guard the gates so that no merchandise could be brought in on the Sabbath day. Neh. 13:19 NLT

6. We don't do our own pleasure, think our own thoughts or speak our own words "Keep the Sabbath day holy. Don't pursue your own interests on that day, but enjoy the Sabbath and speak of it with delight as Yahweh's holy day. Honor the Sabbath in everything you do on that day, and don't follow your own desires or talk idly. Isa. 58:13 Before the Sabbath begins we clean our house and help prepare the Sabbath meal...

We decorate our house with balloons and banners...




May we shout for joy when we hear of your victory and raise a victory banner in the name of our God. Psalm 20:5 NLT
