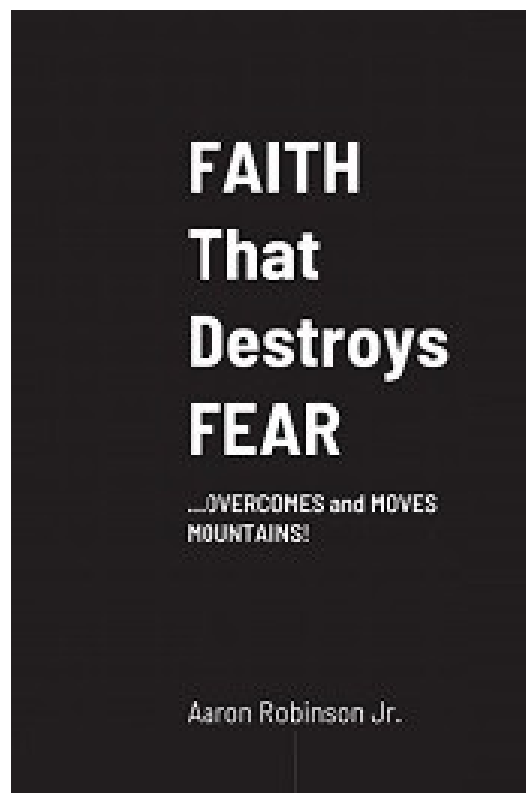

For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Ghost”(2Pet.1:16-21).

3. Obey the Word of God: “Love the Lord and obey his voice” (Deut. 30:20). “Fear God, and keep his commandments” (Eccl. 12:13–14). “Not every one shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of the Father” (Matt. 7:21, 3 Ne. 14:21). See also: (Deut. 11:26-28 KJV), and many other scriptures.

How To Get Favor With God

“Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name” (Php2:9-11)

How comforting it is to have a Savior whose name is above every circumstance, every situation; no matter what you may be facing, or going through, the name of Jesus has you covered... so call out to Him!



When calling on God, what many people tend to overlook is that though God is **'Love'** and wants us to **'prosper'** He has **'established'** rules of engagement, or the relationship conditions by which He agreed to respond to the pleas of those He created. In 2 Chr 7:14 God revealed four such conditions; and in Jer 29:12 He declared through the Old Testament prophet - **"You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with *all your heart*."** Moreover, in Psalms 94:11, and other bible scriptures, God makes it crystal clear that He knows the **'thoughts'** and the **'intentions'** of every human being. So most assuredly, He is quite capable of discerning the difference between those sincerely seeking to have a **'personal relationship'** with Him verses the multitude of casual callers only interested in receiving handouts. The bible teaches that it is through the exercise of our faith; worshiping the Lord in **'spirit'** and in **'truth'** that we are allowed to meet the Father and receive the blessings that come from His hand. To emphasize, 1 John 4:23 states; ***"But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him."*** God only **'rewards'** those believers who are **'diligently'** seeking Him (*Heb 11:6*). In other words, when praying, don't be like some other Christians who often think of God as someone merely at their beck and call, obligated to fulfill every greedy, self-serving request upon demand. Remember, God is not an old man with a long beard, or some kind of magical Genie to grant a person's every wish and whim. As a matter of fact, one's view of God ultimately affects every aspect of their Christian living. Truly, there are many people who claim to know God, yet continue to live their lives oblivious to the person or presence of their Creator until they want something from Him. Ask yourself - ***"Am I truly interested in a personal relationship with the one who gave me life, or am I just interested in the gifts He can give me?"***

Does God answer the **'emergency calls'** of those who truly seek to know Him, love Him and obey His commandments? ***Without a doubt!*** In John 14:21, Jesus said to His disciples; ***"He who has My commandments and keeps them is the one who loves Me; and he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will disclose Myself to him."*** As an example, Psalms 91:14-15 also make it clear such calls to heaven never fall on deaf ears. The LORD says, ***"I will rescue those who love me. I will protect those who trust in my name. When they call on me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue them and honor them."*** God wants those who love Him to bring all their needs to Him. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. If you do this, you will experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the human mind can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7... So, before you call on God it's a good idea to re-examine your motives and make sure you are in a right relationship with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; having **'Faith'** in the Word of God, and your focus on obeying the Lord's commandment to **'Seek First the Kingdom of God'** which is **'Righteousness'**, **'Peace'** and **'Joy'** in the **'Holy Spirit'** in order to please God and accomplish what you are calling on God for (*Matt 6:33; Ro 14:17*). Pray to Jesus for salvation, ask Him to create in you a clean heart, and renew the right spirit in you (*Ps 51:10*), then make your request known unto God. Jesus said in 2 John 15:7, ***"If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you"*** Is Jesus abiding in you through His word?

The following is a list of powerful, emergency and immediate, heartfelt Prayers and their confirming scriptures that you can use in your time of need to petition God's Help fast! 24/7 help when you need it. Pray the **'prayer'** that fits your **'circumstance'** once, believing that you will receive what you are asking God for. Don't be repetitious in your prayer, and ask the Lord to help you overcome any fear, doubt or unbelief you may be experiencing (*Matt 6:7; Mr 9:24*). Then **'meditate'** on the **'corresponding'** scripture while waiting for God to answer (*Jos 1:8*); giving praise and thanks to Him in the name of Jesus (*Joh 16:23:24*). God inhabits the praise of His people (*Ps 22:3*).

Remember, you have to have faith, because it is impossible to please God or receive your victory without it (Heb 11:6). To sum it up, when you are in a 'right relationship' with the Lord, all you have to do is **'believe'** and **'ask'** the Lord to help you (*Matt 21:22; Mr 9:23*). As stated above, be sure to ask Jesus to forgive you for your sins (*1 Jo 1:9*), fill you with His precious Holy Spirit and show you His plans for your life (*1 Jo 4:4; Jer 29:11*).

God is your **'Refuge'** and **'Strength'**; your **Ever-Present Help** in times of need! (*Psalm 46:1*)

“Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.” (*Psalm 4:1*)

Now, go into your *prayer room*, close the door, and call upon the Lord - **“But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly” (*Matthew 6:6 NKJV*)...**

**Praying to God helps the lives of all those who believe...
"The Prayer of Faith shall save the sick". (James 5:15).**

What is prayer?

Prayer is our speaking from our hearts to our heavenly Father, prompted by the power of the Holy Spirit within the believer, through a right relationship with Jesus Christ, to articulate our deepest thoughts and reveal a heart of thankfulness. Prayer that works and is effective requires Faith, Hope, Love, Belief, Trust and Patience which are just a few of the vital virtues needed when communicating our thoughts, needs and thankfulness to God through Jesus Christ. Prayers that are likely to receive answers are those prayed in accordance with God's plans, purposes and timing which fulfill His temporal and eternal will for your life.

The grace of God enables us; while our communication through prayer keeps us close and connected to God through Jesus Christ. An active, effective prayer life maintains the connectedness which offers strength and enrichment to our lives...

Proper Communication With God is Crucial in Order for the Lord to HEAR and ANSWER your Prayer

Communicating With God:

1. First, God speaks to us through His Word (2 Timothy 3:16-17. Isaiah 55:11) tells us: So is my word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. Since the Bible is God's words, man can trust that when he is in a right relationship with God, and he reads the Bible, he is literally hearing God's spoken word. **"If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."** (John 15:7),
2. Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth (John 9:31). Since the Bible says that God hears man (Psalm 17:6, 77:1; Isaiah 38:5), man can trust that when he is in a right relationship with God and he speaks to God, God will hear him.
3. The right relationship with God that is necessary for healthy communication between God and man is evidenced in the following ways:

First is a turning from sin, or repentance. Psalm 27:9, for example, is the plea of David for God to hear him and not turn away from him in anger. From this, we know that God does turn His face away from man's sin and that sin hinders the communication between God and man. Another example of this is found in Isaiah 59:2, where Isaiah tells the people, But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear. So, when there is unconfessed sin in our lives, it will hinder communication with God.

Next, a humble heart is necessary for effective communication with God. God speaks these words in Isaiah 66:2, This is the one I esteem: he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and trembles at my word.

Being humble and sincere before God should be quite simple, but it can become complex if the one praying is prideful and unrepentant. Confessing our weaknesses and our sins to God with a continual heart of repentance keeps the communication of prayer honest and open with God through the power of the Holy Spirit given by Jesus Christ.

The third thing is a righteous life. This is the positive side of turning from sin and is marked specifically by effectiveness in prayer. The prayer of a man/woman who is right with God (being sincere and prays according to God's will in Jesus Name) is powerful and effective. (James 5:16).

Finally we must have faith; be confident that He will hear us and that the Holy Spirit will help us to pray what we ought to pray. Romans 8:26 says, In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. Believe that when we pray, asking anything according to His will and in the name of Jesus, He hears us, and will give us what we pray for. Remember, it is impossible to please God without faith.

Avoid approaching God with repetitious prayers (Matthew 6:7) and carnal (fleshly or self-pleasing) requests that look to meet our plans and purposes while they may not be according to His will. Sometimes we expect God to give us what we want, when we want, it instead of trusting Him with our life, and what He deems good, just and purposeful.

Steps to Effectual Prayer:

1. Believe as you pray, that God hears and answers prayer.
2. Pray in the spirit, pray in tongues, fast... "the more critical the condition... the more crucial the preparation."
3. Remember, Healing is gradual, and Miracles are instant. Sometimes healing will come in stages, as you continue to pray for your loved one.
4. Be patient, be for real, believe that God will honor your Faith. "God wants to make the person whole in all areas of their life...body, soul, and spirit."
5. Be sure to Thank God for whatever He does....

"The Fervent, and Effectual Prayer of a Righteous Man will avail much" (James 5:16)
"I will Restore health to You, and Your wounds I will heal, says the Lord." (Jer. 30:17)

1. Before You Pray...

1. Be sure to confess any sins, and ask God to forgive you.
2. Develop the Right Attitude: Love, Peace, Forgiveness, and Joy in the Holy Ghost.
3. Develop a prayer life: Prayer is not just a 'part' of your spiritual life, but the 'thing' that keeps your spiritual life going.
4. Develop Confidence: The bible teaches that God answers prayer (Matt. 7:7-8, John 16:24, James 4:2). "Many Christians will get frustrated, and stop praying, when their prayers don't seem to get answered." Satan causes you to doubt the effectiveness of prayer... un-answered prayer is an abnormality, and should be dealt with.

2. Essentials to Answered Prayer:

1. **Pray without Ceasing:** Never stop communicating with God, ie a. (sharing your feelings and thoughts with God. - b. Understanding God: Meditating on God, and His Word, comprehending God's feelings, and His will for you. - c. Worship God: Glorify, praise, and follow God in obedience.
2. **Pray with Faith:** It is impossible to please God without faith: A. God exists (Heb. 11:6): - B. God is approachable (Hebrews 4:16, Col 1:15, James 4:8). - C. God is a rewarder (Luke 11:9-10, John 16:24, Heb. 11:6). Faith pleases God... and Perfect Faith well pleases God.
3. **Pray according to God's will:** "And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:" 1 John 5:14).

Some Hindrances to Answered Prayer include: Unconfessed Sin - Unforgiveness - Not Born Again - Lack of Faith - Disobedience

3. When You Pray:

1. Identify Your Need: Be specific in your request to God.
2. Search the Scriptures(Concordance): Read all scripture that promise to meet your need, and pray those scriptures back to God.
3. Address Your Prayer to God, in the Name of Jesus. God is the source, Jesus is the way or door to God.
4. Develop an Attitude of Praise and Worship: Praise and give thanks to God.
5. Ask in Accordance to the Word: God Honors His Word.
6. Clear Your Mind: Think pure, positive thoughts. Meditate on the Word.
7. Exercise Faith...Believe: Know that God hears and answers prayer.
8. See It: Visualize your needs being met by God.
9. Make Intercession: Pray for the needs of someone else.
10. Ask Only Once: To pray repetitious prayers is unbelief. Rather, pray Confirming Prayers to God... Praying His Word back to Him; "God's Word will not return to Him void. (Isaiah 55:11).

Possible Answers You May Receive From God To Your Prayer Requests :

1. Yes: God may answer your prayers in the way that you request.
2. God may Delay His answer to impress upon us our need for Him.
3. We may not be spiritually ready to receive that we have petitioned God for.
4. For His own reasons, God may decide... Not Yet.
5. No: Sometimes God denies our requests

Bottom line. Develop an '*effectual*' prayer life: Remember, prayer is not just a '*part*' of your spiritual life, but the '*thing*' that keeps your spiritual life going... **“Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. 7) And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus”** (*Philippians 4:6-8*).

“Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need” (*Hebrews 4:16 KJV*)



When you have sinned

Prayer: “Forgive me my sins, O Lord; forgive me for the sins of my youth and the sins of mine age. Forgive my secret sins, and forgive me for those sins which I know, and the sins which I have forgotten; please forgive them all.” In Jesus’ name, Amen.

Confirming Scripture: “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness”. 1 John 1:9. See also Psalm 51:1-2, Romans 3:23-1 John 1:10, 1 John 2:1-29.

When you want God’s salvation

Prayer: “Dear Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and need Your forgiveness. I believe that You died, rose from the grave, and is now seated at the right hand of God. I know you did this to purchase my freedom and deliver my soul from eternal damnation. Lord Jesus come into my heart; take control of my life; forgive my sins and save me. I repent of my sins, and I want to trust and follow You as Lord and Savior. I accept the free gift of eternal life.” In Jesus’ name amen.

Confirming Scripture: “For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” John 3:16 (KJV). See also: John 17:3, Romans 6:23, John 1:12, Ephesians 2:8-9, and many other scriptures.
