INTRODUCTION

Below is a short list of some of the ancient gods that were worshipped during the time of Jesus Christ. His new religion, that we now call Christianity, was instrumental in eliminating these ancient beliefs and replacing these old worships with that of the new Christianity. One of the first tasks of the early Christians was to travel to every village and country they could, preaching the Word. The aim was to eradicate all these ancient beliefs. This practice is still in use today, and many doctrines of Christianity still send missionaries to a variety of lands and countries to do exactly this. The belief is that **“there are no such things as gods!”** The poor tribes in New Guinea or in South America as in other places have all had their belief systems challenged if not destroyed by modern day missionaries.

Unfortunately Christian doctrines only ever succeeded in replacing one belief system with another just as intolerant and inane as the cult it replaced. After saying that ‘there are no such things as gods’ they now claim that there really **is** such a thing as a god, but only on their terms. However you can’t say on one hand that ‘there are no such things as gods’ and then contradict it by saying “hang on, there is one god!”

The fact of the matter is this; Christianity today is not teaching the same principles that Jesus set up. Jesus actually said **“There are no such things as gods – period!”** He said **“God is an ideal!”** He said **“You can be born of this ideal too and also be called a son of god!”** He said **“God dwells within you!”** He said **“God is a God of the living not a god of the dead!”** He said **there are no such things as gods; just as there are no such places as Heaven or Hell and there is no such person as Satan and Sin does not exist either. Especially Sin does not exist!** By doing this He was able to show the folly of vain worship and the crippling effect of guilt and sin on a mind clouded by misconception. He was then able to forgive sin which meant that His patients **believed** that their sin had been abolished.

There are many things He said that show if not prove that **“There are no such things as gods! – Heaven; Hell; Satan and Sin”**

The intent of Christianity is to destroy or prove that these other gods were nothing more than delusions set up by the high priests or Shamans of the day, who had a vested interest in reaping a harvest off the followers. CONCEPT ONE ✂ SIGN OF THE TIMES

At the time of Christ, some two-thousand years ago, the superpowers of the day, namely Egypt, Greece and Rome, all worshipped a plethora of gods. Jesus recognised that such belief systems were a folly that corrupted the minds of the followers, with dogma that led to delusion and misconception. Religions which held onto false ancient beliefs, also observed a number of wrongful practices such as sacrificing animals and sometimes even people. The governing bodies of priests, Shamans and powerful religious leaders also made many corrupt laws and taxes aimed at enriching the powerful elite by subjugating the poor.

Jesus felt it was time the modern world learned the truth about religion. He came to the Middle East with a new message from an ancient religion. The Jews had practiced monotheism for centuries prior to Jesus' time. Monotheism was nothing new to Jesus or the ancient world, but even this one-god viewpoint, was incorrect as far as Jesus was concerned. He was not bringing monotheism to a world that already had monotheism. Instead, He went on to as many villages as he could, saying such things as; **“Why do you worship a plethora of gods? Don't you know that there are no such things as gods?”**

Lu:17:21: Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, **the kingdom of God is within you.**

More of his actual words are recorded in the four gospels and His verses will be repeated here, for the convenience of the reader, taken from King James Version of the Bible. There are many Bibles around these days but most have been edited by people with dogmatic viewpoints and by people who believe the common conception that God exists. These corrected editions cause conflict when examined truthfully because there are many heretical passages in the Bible. Since people who believe that a god exists cannot fathom why there should be heretical phrases in the Bible, they simply delete them or change the wording in order to make such phrases conform to their own opinion to be more appealing to a dogmatic viewpoint. Even the modern Bible is not free of modern corruption of thought so that only one perspective can be drawn, which is that god exists. Therefore the King James Version has been chosen as an authority to be made an example of, as it is mostly free of modern day thought vandalism. It is said that these new versions of the Bible *correct* many *inconsistencies* of the King James Version but these so called inconsistencies are purposeful ones that the Disciples and writers of the Gospels and Prophets and other writers were very much aware of. These so called inconsistencies guide the reader to question what is being read in the Bible in order to initiate a search for truth, however modern day corrected bibles with the inconsistencies taken out, quell the need to search for truthfulness beyond the call of God. Hence modern day bibles only promote and perpetuate the dogma of the group responsible for that particular version of the bible and do not provide incentive for a reader to question what is actually in the Bible. It seems that every different Christian denomination these days has its own version of the Bible all of which are different. This defacing of scripture is done even in the face of warnings not to do such a thing as we find in Revelations

Re:22:19: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

Modern day corrected versions of the Bible are notorious for replacing exact meaning with what somebody else thinks the author should have meant. No-one has the authority to say that “*Jesus actually meant to say so and so.*” No-one living today was actually there and therefore has no right to change the words or meanings of scripture. This type of Biblical correction is called paraphrasing. Paraphrasing or anticipating what the writers of the Gospels might have meant is very harmful because unless the person doing the paraphrasing has an exact like-mindedness of the Gospel writers themselves, there can be no similarity.

The words of Jesus Christ are everlasting and the message is clear, **that there are no such things as gods.** This is the most fundamental teaching of all from which stems all the insights and benefits to mankind that truthfulness and purity of mind can afford. Jesus taught His disciples the same message, and they continued His work, preaching this illumination long after His demise. They went from village to village teaching ‘There are no such things as Gods’ and the new Christian effort that arose, purged most of the Middle East and Europe of polytheism and perverted worship. We see evidence of this heretical teaching in verse, for example the following from Luke. Jesus’s words are concise and simple as He intimated that we the people were as Gods ourselves.

*Joh:10:34: Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, **I said, Ye are gods?***

He said very clearly that God was an ideal.

*Lu:17:20: And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh **not with observation:***

*Lu:17:21: Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, **the kingdom of God is within you.***

In this verse Jesus reveals two major concepts the first is that **god cannot be found anywhere that you might seek Him** and the second is **that god dwells within us.** Stating that the Kingdom of God was within people, meant that God was not a super being seated on a throne in a place called Heaven at all, but was actually an **IDEAL** within us that Jesus and His followers clung to and believed in. God was **NOT** a supernatural BEING but was instead a belief in **TRUTHFULNESS** and **Honesty** and a commitment to do good work.

If there were no such things as gods then Jesus reasoned that there was no such thing as a singular God period. A true belief in god was a belief in the ideals and morals that one would expect if god were real. Seeing that god was an imaginary archetype, Jesus then set about teaching the **type of behaviours people should adopt**, in order to reflect such a belief. In other words, the followers themselves portrayed a type of godliness, through their beliefs and behaviours, without the need for an actual god. **God was merely the personification of this behaviour. This is the truth.**

*Joh:1:12: But as many as received him, **to them gave he power to become the sons of God,** even to them that believe on his name:*

The Bible is full of heretical sayings that offend people who strictly believe that God exists in Heaven. Therefore their Bibles are heavily worded to reflect this belief but the real evidence actually points to Jesus teaching the freedom of atheism. Jesus recognised that He could not just come out with claims that the imagined god did not actually exist; He had to prove to people, that what they read in their Bibles, and their interpretation of that reading, was in fact altogether misunderstood. The basic premise that a god existed, corrupted the mind with a false belief or delusion that sullied every other thought and decision the person held. The problem was how does one achieve such a goal as proving atheism? In fact this very problem still exists today, even in the face of such overwhelming evidence as the theory of evolution, not to mention all the other sciences, chemistry, physics, astrophysics and quantum mechanics; the church continues to argue for spontaneous creation by a creator. Nowadays they have masked it yet again by referring to it as “Intelligent Design” but it makes no difference what you call it “Spontaneous Creation”; “intelligent Design”; “Creation by God”; it all underlies **a belief that some god created the Earth**. The problem with this belief, apart from the fact that it is misled, is the fact that it denies logic and is harmful as a viewpoint. To argue that Dinosaurs did not exist, even while holding a dinosaur bone in your hand, is to demonstrate bigotry. To say that God is larger than the universe which He must have created, then to say He dwells on Mount Zion is ludicrous

Joe:3:21: For I will cleanse their blood that I have not cleansed: for the LORD dwelleth in Zion..

Most people are unaware of the truthful nature of Jesus’s teachings, because most doctrines do not teach it, in fact no-one teaches it. Having been influenced since the beginning of time by the imagined presence of a god, the case for an atheistic but truthful lifestyle, threatens the established theologies with losing their grip on the congregation. They were and are trapped by their own dogma.

If a person’s mind is affected by a basic delusion such as religious dogma, how can they ever come to the knowledge of truthful teachings such as science? The difference of believing in science, as opposed to religion, is that with science the beliefs are **constantly changing and being corrected as new definitions are found**, but with religious dogma one believes the same unchanging myth, as the ancestors did, forever, and such a mind is incapable of accepting new change; new challenges and new truths, for fear of being proved wrong or perhaps fear of being dammed.

Jesus said nobody has ever seen any such thing as a god.

*Joh:1:18: **No man hath seen God** at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.*

Saying that “**No man or person has ever seen God at any time**” is stating the obvious, that there is no evidence that a god exists at all. We have only the word of the priest (who also has never seen any god) as evidence that there actually is a god, and this word of the priest is only an account of that one priest’s imagination. In fact all interpretation emanates from the imagination of the men at the top of the hierarchy who have a vested interest in perpetrating the delusion. Because of the nature of imagination and personal interpretation of scripture,

there have been countless disputes over what is the most perfect doctrine of all. Hence we now have a plethora of Christian denominations, all of whom fall under the same God-spell.

Nobody has ever seen any god or any such things as gods. The notion that god created the earth is problematic to say the least; as such a creation implies that the whole universe was created by a god. God therefore would need to be bigger than the universe itself, if such a god existed. Not only that but all the Laws governing science, nature and mathematics in both microcosms and macrocosms, would have been created by the same god and so would all the parallel universes. The big bang itself would have been such a creation, and the list goes on and on until the very thought of someone or something being so enormous but still focusing on the earth, becomes totally preposterous.

Jesus said explicitly to His disciples, that **God is an IDEAL**. This IDEAL is a belief in good as opposed to a belief in evil. A belief in goodness required a commitment to do good work, in all aspects of life. This public commitment was demonstrated and became known as the Baptism. This teaching was that we should help others, and to turn the other cheek when someone wronged us.

M't:5:39: But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, **turn to him the other also**.

Lu:6:29: And unto him that smiteth thee on the one cheek **offer also the other**; and him that taketh away thy cloke forbid not to take thy coat also.

Jesus taught us to love thy neighbour as thyself, this concept was termed the second great commandment and it reflects the notion that God dwells within us or indeed in all people, as the first great commandment states, that we should love god (the Ideal) with all our heart.

M't:22:36: Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

M't:22:37: Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

M't:22:38: This is the first and great commandment.

*M't:22:39: And the second is like unto it, **Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself**.*

However Jesus's God was an Ideal of doing good deeds. Imagine it this way; if you add an 'O' to the word 'GOD', you get 'GOOD'. To love God is to love Good. A decision to serve God should be a decision to serve Good. Life presents us with a simple but critical choice, either we promote goodness or we choose evil, which is to be uncaring and unmindful of others. This is the great choice all people are faced with sometime during their life; to serve 'Good' (God) or Evil.

M't:6:24: **No man can serve two masters**: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Lu:16:13: **No servant can serve two masters**: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

It is stated in the Bible that to serve Evil is to be unaware of moral standards and such people live their lives in darkness not knowing or understanding the value of promoting goodness or morals for the benefit of society. Planting the seeds of goodness in young children will see them grow into reliable and caring parents themselves but the alternative only produces selfish and uncaring adults.

These teachings were far superior and vastly different, from the teachings of the Jewish Hierarchy at the time, which were only trumpeting monotheism, as well as vain repetitions of dogma (exactly what they continue today). Not only that, but as Jesus taught that there are no such things as gods (or indeed a God) the hierarchy realised that His teachings would turn people away from the established synagogues, which earned their income. Therefore He was hated by the hierarchy because He was seen as being an anti-god heretic. He was in fact just being truthful and honest in all His attempts at verbalising the enlightenment of truth. To this end he said such things as the Pharisees and Sadducees were vain to believe that a god created all things. Not only this, but that they knew the truth once, and had turned this pure atheistic truth into the philosophy of lies that perpetuated the delusion that god actually exists.

*Ro:1:21: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became **vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.***

Ro:1:22: Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

Ro:1:23: And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

Ro:1:24: Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:

*Ro:1:25: **Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.***

He said that the hierarchy were vain in their imaginations and that they had turned the TRUTH into a lie. This of course meant that instead of worshipping god as an IDEAL they worshipped god as an 'omnipotent being' which was in fact total idolatry.

Being vain in their imaginations refers to the vanity of worshipping an imagined god – any god – or all gods. This is called IDOLATRY. Since there are no such things as gods, then by definition worshipping of any god was vain. Jesus knew this truth well. To say that there even was one god above all others was also verging on a deception that Jesus often referred to as the covering or **veil of heaven**. This is the Dark Confession of Christ's knowledge. When Jesus spoke of God (His adopted God Ideal) He referred to a model which was fashioned after the similitude of a family, whereby God was seen as the Father.

Joh:5:17: But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.

*Joh:5:18: Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that **God was his Father**, making himself equal with God.*

The whole premise was that the adopted Father ruled the house but also set an example of behaviour for the other members of the family. God was made to be an adopted Father. By this process of ‘**adoption**’ people became sons and daughters to the Ideal Father (God).

*Joh:1:12: But as many as received him, **to them gave he power to become the sons of God**, even to them that believe on his name:*

The adoption of God as a Father made them the adopted sons and daughters of God. The whole premise of God was and always had been an invention of society. For this reason god was called **the creature** and not the creator, of the creation story. **The creator of god was society** which Jesus understood and this will be explained soon. The creature which is the ‘concept of god’ was nothing more than someone’s opinion of what might be, if heaven was real.

*Ro:1:25: **Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator**, who is blessed for ever. Amen.*

Society was the creator of ‘god’ and it was society that any good Christian pledged to serve. There is absolutely no point in sacrificing animals or people or even offering foodstuffs to a god that doesn’t exist; doing so is simply vain and a useless waste. Jesus however was not fooled by the rhetoric of dogma, because He knew what truthfulness and honesty was all about. He had an uncanny ability to see beyond the imagined world and into the truths of scripture, wherein these confessions are found. The Christian Bible (New Testament) is the **only religious document in the world that will confess that god is an ideal.**

*Ac:24:14: But this **I confess** unto thee, that after **the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God** of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:*

The Pharisees called such beliefs Heresy and Paul even writes of, explains and confesses his own Heresy in Acts as above. The confession is that the Bible even the Old Testament contains these heretical notions that god is an ideal. Even giving the impression of worshipping god is called idolatry. The truth that there are no such things as gods is scattered all through both Old and New Testaments.

Jesus held a pure concept of religion even to the point of witnessing the hypocrisy of those who profess godly knowledge but constantly did actions contrary to scripture’s instructions.

*Ti:1:14: Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, **that turn from the truth.***

*Ti:1:15: **Unto the pure all things are pure:** but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but **even their mind and conscience is defiled.***

*Ti:1:16: **They profess that they know God;** but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.*

Jesus discovered that the Truth of God was **hidden by a covering of myth and metaphor of parable and idiom**. Only those people with pure intentions (atheists and agnostics) have any chance of recognising whatever truths are wrapped up in this way. In fact many people these days already know in their hearts that god is a myth, or an ideal, and that religion is not to be taken too seriously. This testifies that good people value truth and goodness over dogma and hypocrisy any day.

Ti:1:15: **Unto the pure all things are pure**: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.

The whole of Jesus' teachings proclaim this very issue. The notion that the truth is hidden by this 'covering' is consistent from Genesis to Revelation. It is central to understanding the message against idolatry. Idolatry was the one colossal sin that Israel always resorted to, even after being severely admonished, time and time again by the Prophets. Idolatry is basically interpreted as worshipping idols as gods but the biblical interpretation is that of worshipping any gods at all. To give one's mind over to worshipping god or gods is to surrender one's own discerning ability, to oppression of thought by others. Gods do not exist, so to worship something that does not exist, or to worship anything at all, is to surrender one's own will power. This is offensive to those who cherish holistic viewpoints of the self. Such surrender always commits the individual's viewpoint to oppression of thought by others.

Below is an extract from Exodus concerning the idolatry of the Jews even whilst Moses was on the Mountain receiving the Ten Commandments?

Ex:32:22: And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they are set on mischief.

*Ex:32:23: For they said unto me, **Make us gods**, which shall go before us: for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.*

Ex:32:24: And I said unto them, Whosoever hath any gold, let them break it off. So they gave it me: then I cast it into the fire, and there came out this calf.

*Ex:32:25: **And when Moses saw that the people were naked; (for Aaron had made them naked unto their shame among their enemies:)***

Ex:32:26: Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD's side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.

*Ex:32:27: And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, **and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.***

*Ex:32:28: And the children of Levi did according to the word of Moses: and there fell of the people that day **about three thousand men.***

Moses saw that the **people were NAKED** in their worship of god. This nakedness will be discussed further soon enough but for now it implies spiritual nakedness (the fear that Moses was not returning and they would be left without a god). You have heard of the "Naked Truth" well the naked truth is truth that is not covered by misleading description that hides the real truth from our minds.

*The fable of the **naked truth** says that Truth and falsehood went bathing. Falsehood came first out of the water and dressed herself in Truth's garments. Truth being unwilling to take the garments of Falsehood went naked. "Dictionary of Phrase and Fable – Brewer"*

It was said that Moses was the only person who could "talk with God" because only he knew the secret of how to do this. The Truth is that Moses invented his own impression of God. Therefore Aaron was used as a mouthpiece to intercede for Moses and the people.

Ex:4:14: And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, Is not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart.

*Ex:4:15: And thou shalt speak unto him, **and put words in his mouth:** and I will be with thy mouth, and with his mouth, and will teach you what ye shall do.*

*Ex:4:16: And he shall be thy spokesman unto the people: and he shall be, **even he shall be to thee instead of a mouth, and thou shalt be to him instead of God.***

Ex:4:17: And thou shalt take this rod in thine hand, wherewith thou shalt do signs.

God (Moses's conscience) told Moses; Moses told Aaron; Aaron told the people and somewhere in the retelling the truth became distorted. The scripture said that instead of God, Aaron had Moses. Aaron disguised the things that Moses told him. Whether he knew that there was no such thing as god as Moses did or whether he believed that there actually was a god we do not know. All we know is that Moses (being spiritually naked) knew there are no such things as gods (the naked truth) but the people continually resorted to idolatry i.e. worshipping god, or clothing their beliefs with fables and worship; obviously they believed that God existed hence their idolatry.

Today many people choose atheism, not because of anything that is written in the Bible but because of the stockpile of true knowledge that we have today with Universities and Schools, Book stores and Libraries, the Internet and Television. These resources are so overwhelming that there simply is no room for out-dated concerns such as god worship. The Grace of God which is simply the covering of stories and fables and rituals such as feasts and fasts is seen as nothing more than services and ceremonies. People still get married in churches but just as many choose Celebrants instead of Pastors. The ambivalence demonstrated by modern society for religion in general signifies a movement away from traditional religious attendance. Most churches these days will admit that their numbers of attendees is dropping off. Therefore religious movements this century have attempted to re-invent Christianity with the advent of movements such as New-Age Christian Outreach Worship which include the so called 'speaking in tongues' and the 'Laying on of Hands' to heal the sick and 'fervent prophecy' as well as other gimmicks to infatuate the congregation. All these 'Born Again' methodologies appeal to those people seeking solace in such emotive methods of worship but isn't this exactly what the covering or veil or mystery of God is all about?

Fortunately most of the population in our western society are not enticed by such charismatic and passionate cults as these for very long and the thirst for knowledge and hunger for truth usually leads people into more truthful, honest and sincere expressions of doctrine or scholastic endeavours.

Jesus was adamant about truth. He took every opportunity to teach truthfulness. It was as if there was nothing more important on earth than being sincere, honest and truthful.

Joh:8:32: **And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.**

Even for Pontus Pilate all Jesus said in His own defence was I seek the Truth.

Joh:18:37: Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that **I should bear witness unto the truth**. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

So it is with this in mind that we accept scripture not so much for the comfort of the veil which we now understand to be nothing more than a psychological unguent for a longing soul but for the stringent quality of the truth that God is within us.

It is this same truth that reveals to us the 'cloak' or 'veil' of god which constitutes the 'mystery of god' referred to so often throughout the New Testament.

Re:10:7: But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel (messenger), when he shall begin to sound, the **mystery of God** should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

Joh:15:22: If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now **they have no cloke for their sin**.

We witness that the 'mystery of God' is finished or at least revealed by doctrine such as this little book, and others like it, that show that vain worship is a sickness of the mind which leads mental health astray with inspirations of grandeur, that are in fact hollow. The New Age doctrines promote such ill motivated behaviour and strong infatuation and supply false information in order to glean from them a tidy income impossible when people know the truth. Sober truthfulness was once attractive to the general public. In this day and age it is difficult to find people who value truth and even old morals. The new generations seem to be Hedonistic and self-indulging without care of consequences of behaviour. They desire instant gratification even if it is falsely inspired. It is clear that a new teaching is required to revive old norms and values and simple respect for others without the expectation of reward for everything they do.

Hence we see that a dying away of traditional churches is taking place, and a somewhat rise and fall of new age church revivals is happening as attendances surge to and fro with new worshippers being baptised and older ones leaving as the novelty wears off. Such worship is solidly pushed via pamphlet drops and promoted on early morning TV shows. These are hard core evangelists that use sin and guilt to berate the public into worship and above all donating money.

Fortunately such schools of gospel enterprise are coming to an end. All religious fads eventually die out by virtue of the momentum of truth that may be slow but is persistently

revealing the falsehoods that misguide the public. The New Testament predicts this gradual decline and uses metaphor to disclose it to those who can understand the sign of the times.

This little book is not a spiritual book. It is a book about spiritual things but in itself is not spiritual. Revealing the truth is academic. It remains truthfully and brutally objective in order to express lessons on what actually exists and not on what can be imagined.

Jesus called Himself the 'Son of Man' in order to get across the notion that He was a visionary born of mankind first 'Son of Mankind' then only after this had been explained was he then called the 'Son of God' because of the adoption of the Ideal of God as a Father figure.

Joh:1:12: But as many as received him, to them gave he power **to become the sons of God**, even to them that believe on his name:

So the first lesson is to realise that God was an Ideal and always had been an Ideal even from Adam and Eve days. This will be revealed to come in this little book.
