“Poverty is a Sin”

Catherine Ponder in her book, *The Dynamic Laws of Prosperity*, said, “It's shockingly good, to be rich!” And explained why poverty is a sin.

Catherine wrote: “And so again I say: It is shockingly right instead of shockingly wrong for you to be prosperous. Obviously, you cannot be very happy if you are poor, and you need not be poor. It is a sin. Poverty is a form of hell caused by man's blindness to God's unlimited good for him. Poverty is a dirty, uncomfortable, degrading experience.”

We live in a world that blackmails rich people. The poor keep getting poorer not because the rich have the monopoly of riches, but because the poor don't believe it's their right as well to be rich.

Some people still nurture an unconscious belief that there could be some virtues in lack. You hear people say, “I’m not rich, but I’m honest” as if riches and honesty are antithetical.

There is nothing good about poverty. The Bible talks about a wise man whose wisdom delivered a city when there was a war. But this wise man was soon forgotten because he was poor!

More crimes are committed by poor people than the rich. A child from a rich family will *likely* have better self-esteem than the one from a poor home. Poor self-esteem is what pushes many young people into crimes.

Poverty shuts down a man's capacity to think. A poor man is always self-centered. His thoughts will only center on himself and his needs. He can't think of helping others.

Poverty is a prison. Think about it, poverty limits your choices in life. If you don't have money, you are forced to stay in a house or neighborhood you don't like, work on a job you hate, (because that is your only source of income,) and settle for second-hands.

Poverty kills your dream. A poor man's dream is limited to survival. He can't think of going on a vacation, build orphanages,

fight to eradicate some diseases, build schools or hospitals, or take quality care of his family.

Wallace D. Wattles, in his book, *The Science of Getting Rich*, said, “Whatever may be said in praise of poverty, the fact remains that it's not possible to live a really complete or successful life unless one is rich. No man can rise to his greatest possible height in talent or soul development unless he has plenty of money; for to unfold the soul and to develop talent he must have many things to use, and he cannot have these things unless he has money to buy them with.”

I have seen people who defend poverty as if there is a special honor for being poor.

I'm not saying all of us were born into wealth. Some people grew up in abject poverty like me. While we didn't choose such situation, we don't have to defend it either.

If you are poor today, your goal is to get out of poverty fast, and I will show you how to do it in this book.

You can change your financial destiny. However, you can't do it unless you have a complete disdain for poverty. If you have a slight affinity for poverty, you will always attract lack at the subconscious level.

This is why I am starting this book by showing you there is no virtue in poverty. You don't become more spiritual by being poor.

The Bible mentions that “silver and gold belong to God.” That shows God is rich, he's not poor. And to become spiritual is to become like God. Would you mind if He decides to share some silver and gold (dollars, and Euros, in today's vocabulary) with you?

One common denominator among the poor is their unconscious hatred for the rich. Because they don't understand the principles of wealth creation, they assume that everyone who is rich must be cutting corners.

Of course, some people have amassed wealth in unethical ways. But those people are not rich, the only thing they have is paper. It's not your duty to judge them; anyone who is breaking the law of fairness will eventually destroy himself without your help.

Judging the rich will generate negative emotions about money, which will drive money away from you.

That said.

Remove your attention from poverty; don't label preachers who talk about money as “Prosperity Preachers.” Would you rather

prefer “Poverty Preachers?” We have enough poverty in our world; the last thing I want is a “Poverty preacher.”

Regardless of your current financial situation, you can become rich. But first, you must throw away your secret admiration for poverty!
