

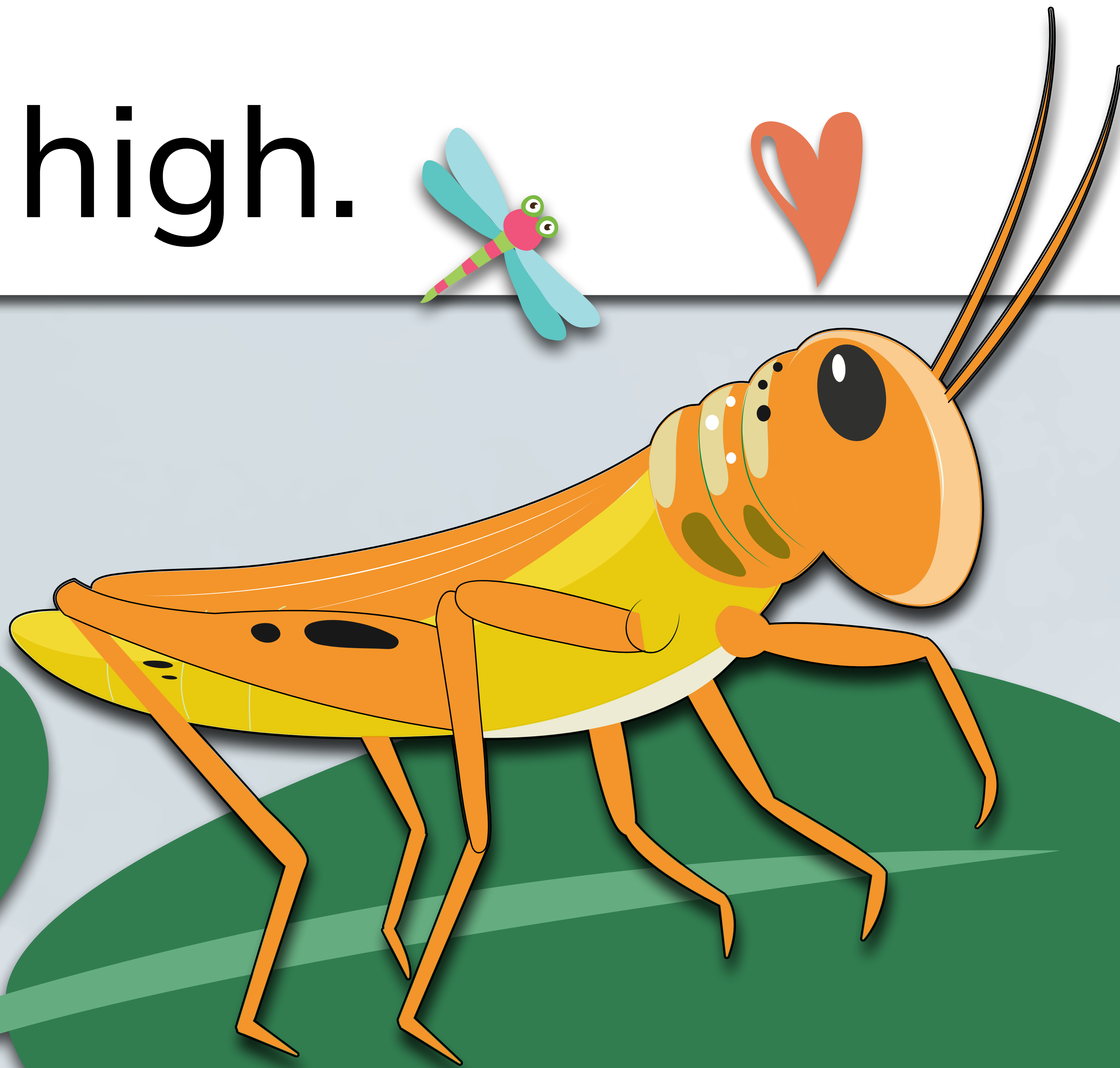
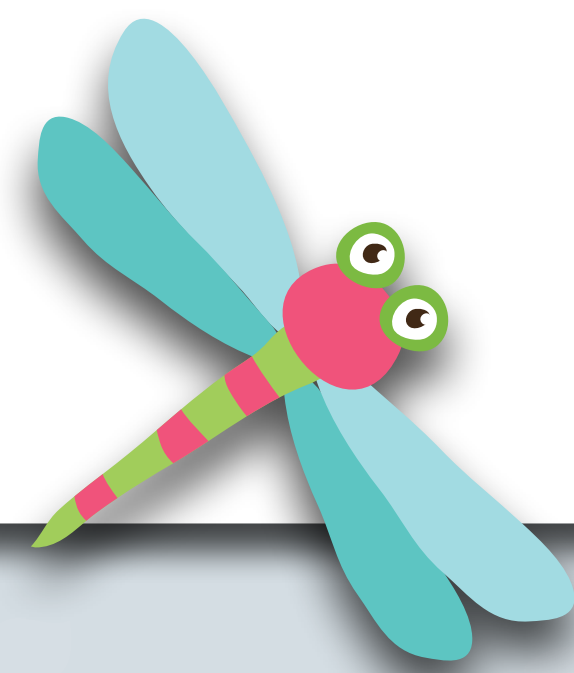

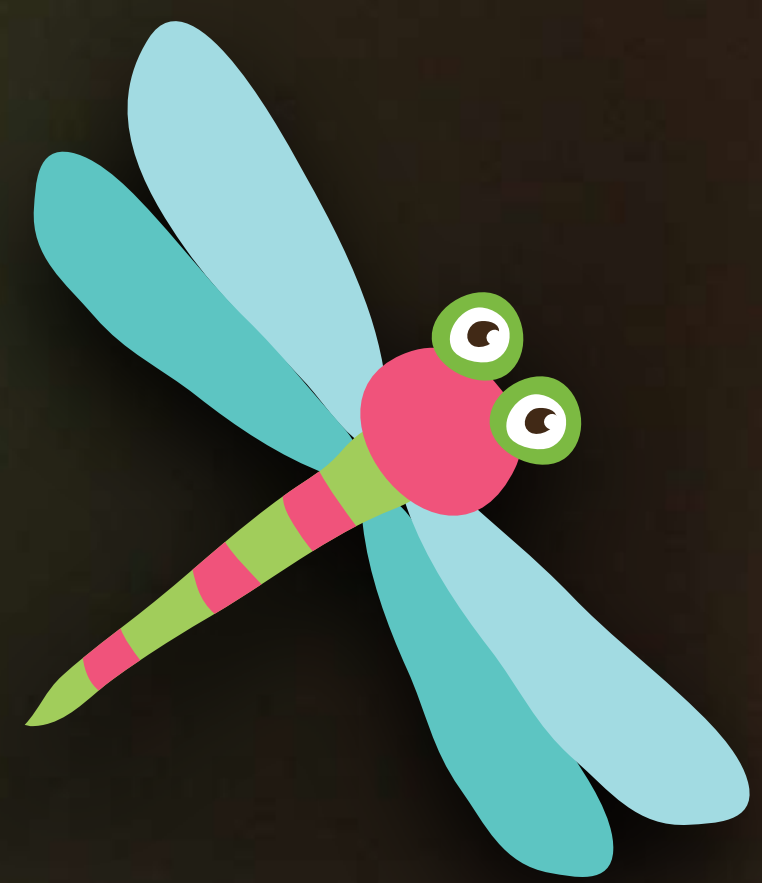

This is an insect. It is a ladybug. Its six little legs are under its shell.



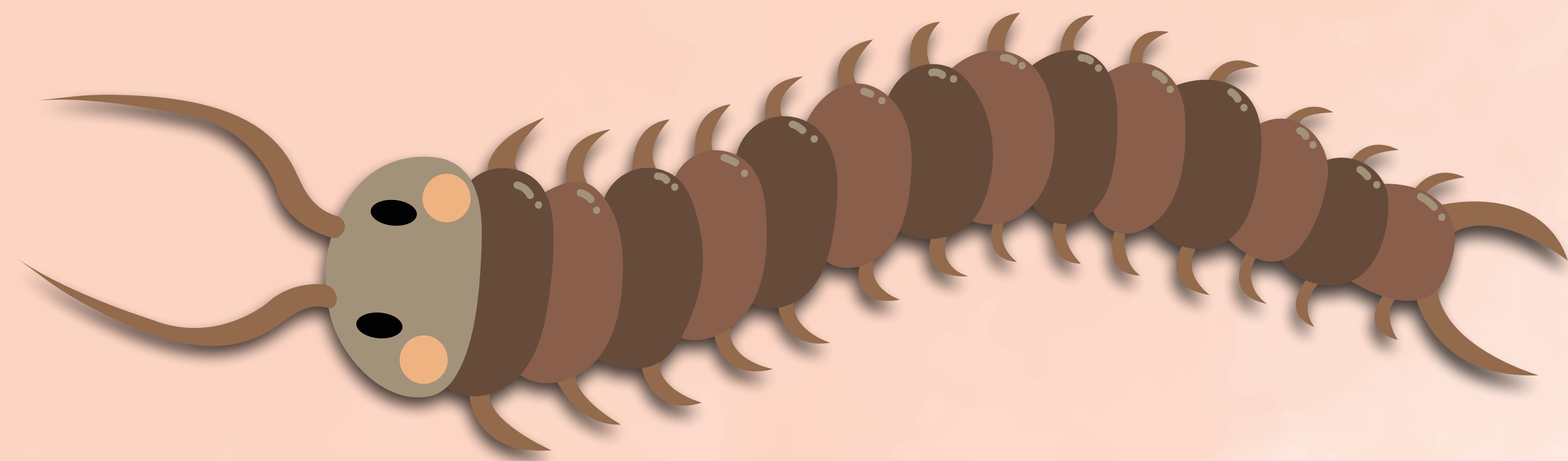


This is an insect. It is an ant. Its six legs are very strong. It can bring things to its nest.





It is not an insect. This is a house centipede. It has a lot of legs.





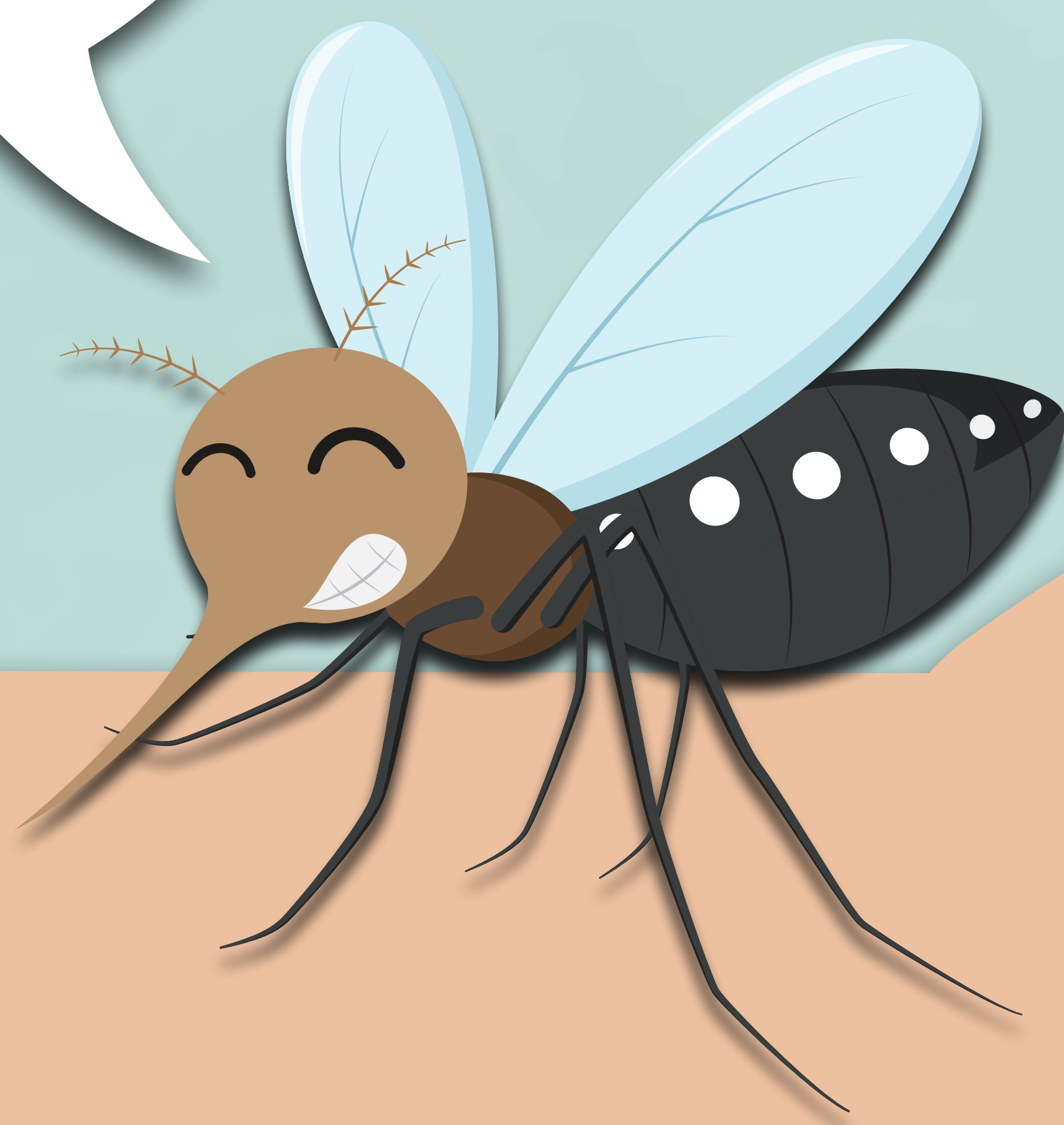


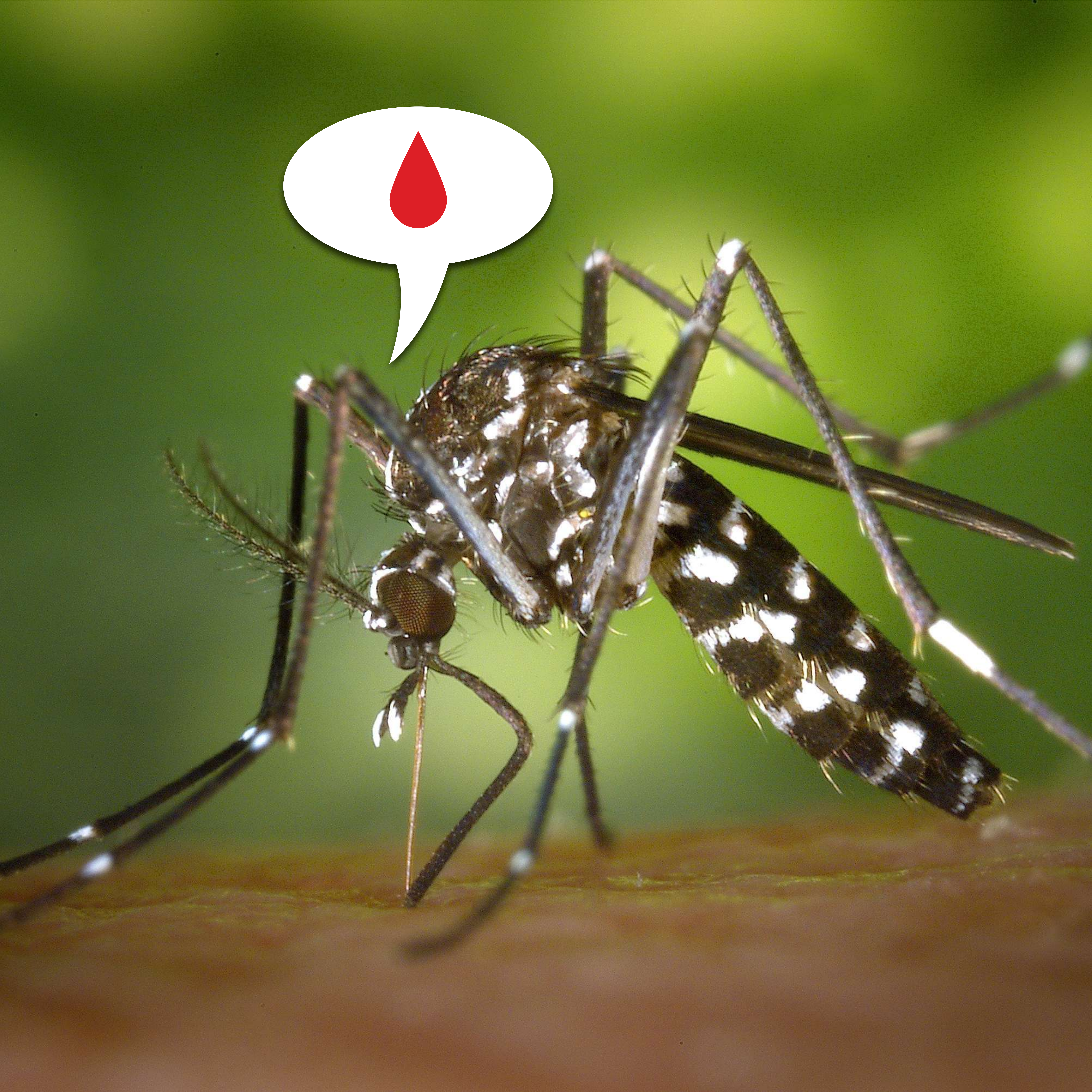
This is an insect. It is a wasp. Its six legs are resting on a flower.
